

## **Alumni Outcomes Survey: 2014 Graduates**

The University of Richmond annually surveys graduates to find out what they are doing five years after graduation. The following are the results from the most recent survey cycle.

- 97% of graduates were satisfied (generally satisfied or very satisfied) with their undergraduate education at the University of Richmond five years after graduation.
- 38% are currently enrolled in or have already completed a graduate program or another undergraduate degree.
- 5% are not currently enrolled but are applying to graduate/professional school.
- Five-year employment rate: 97%
- Median salary range five years after graduation: \$70,000-\$74,999
- Primary Fields of Employment
  - Financial Services/Insurance: 11%Sales/Business Development: 11%
  - o Teaching: 6%
  - o Technology/Information Technology: 6%
  - o Consulting: 5%
  - o Healthcare (Clinical): 5%
  - o Marketing: 5%
  - o Accounting: 4%
  - o Healthcare (Administrative/Research): 4%
  - o Law: 4%
  - o Human Resources: 3%
  - o Public Policy: 2%
  - o Real Estate: 2%
  - o Social Services: 2%
  - o Advertising: 2%
  - o Hospitality & Tourism: 2%
  - o Media/Journalism/Publishing: 2%
  - o Museums & Libraries: 2%

Note: This survey was administered to alumni who graduated in 2014 with a bachelor's degree from the schools of Arts and Sciences, Business, and Jepson. The response rate was 30%.
