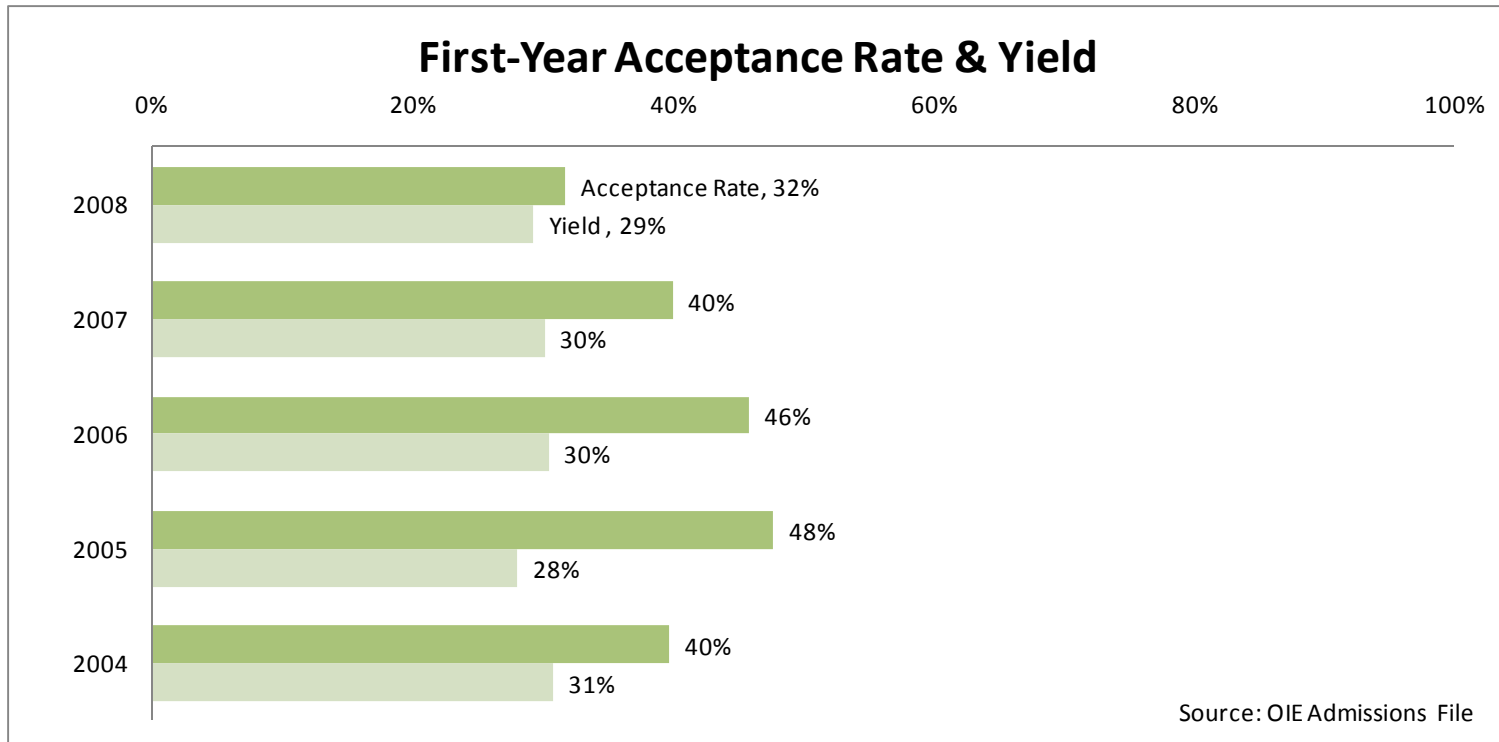

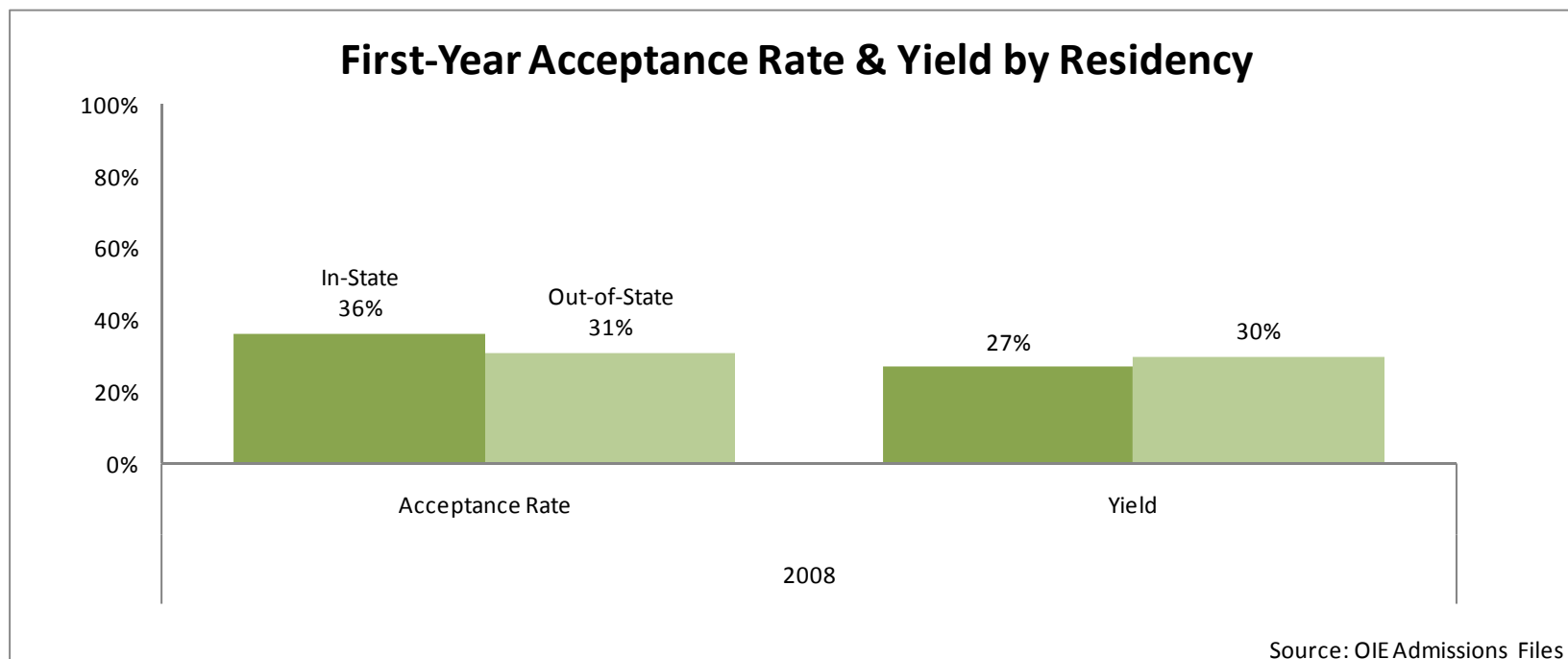

### First-Year Acceptance Rate & Yield by Gender



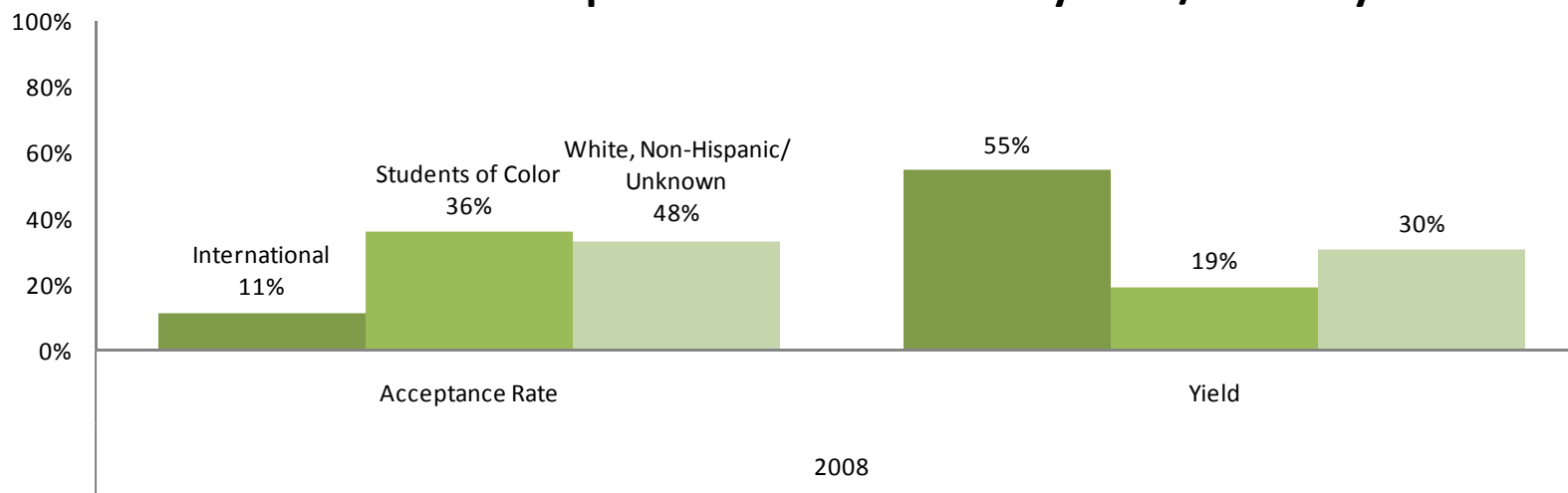

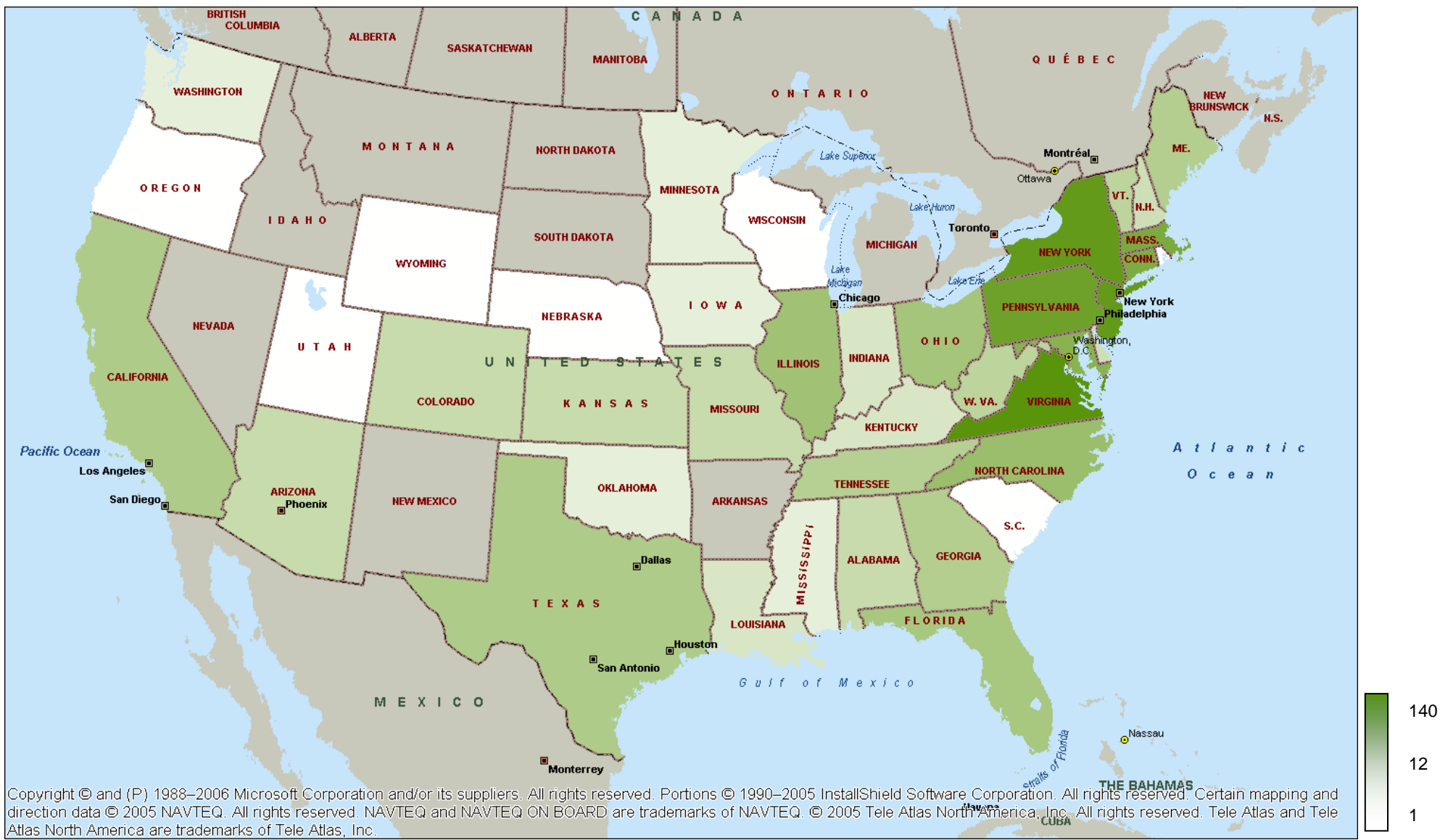

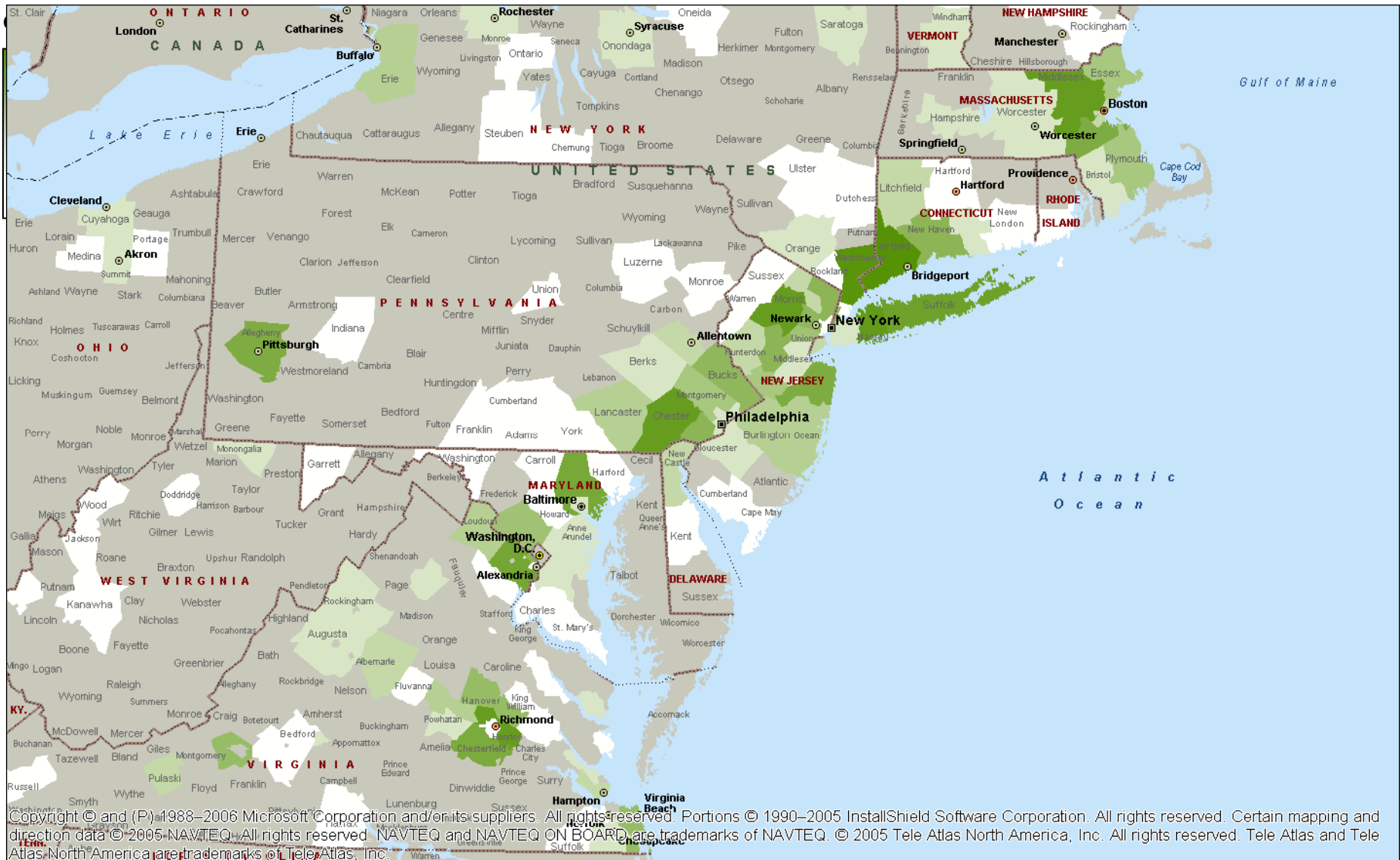
# First-Year by State

# First-Year in High Concentration Areas by County



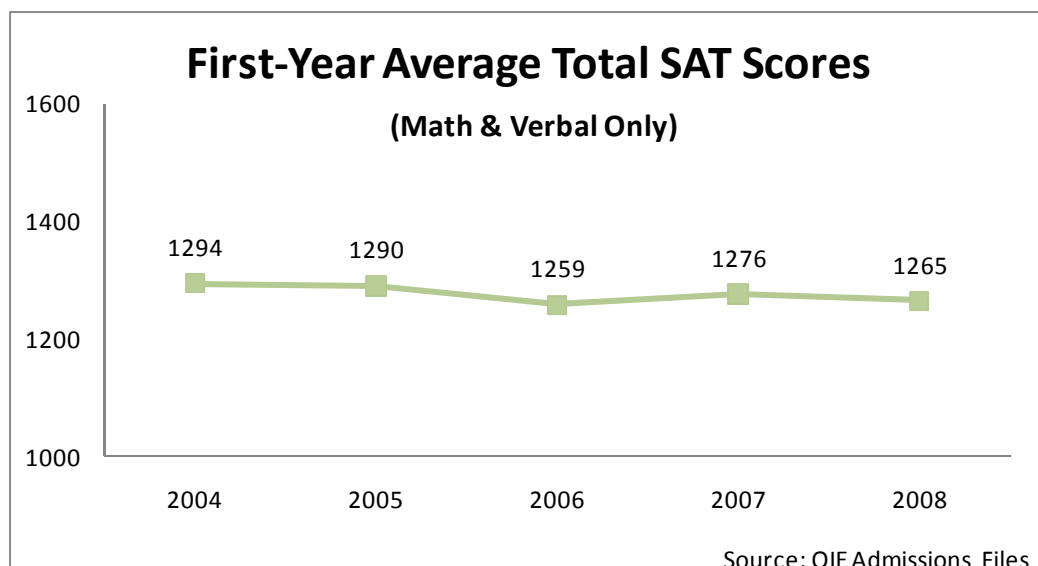

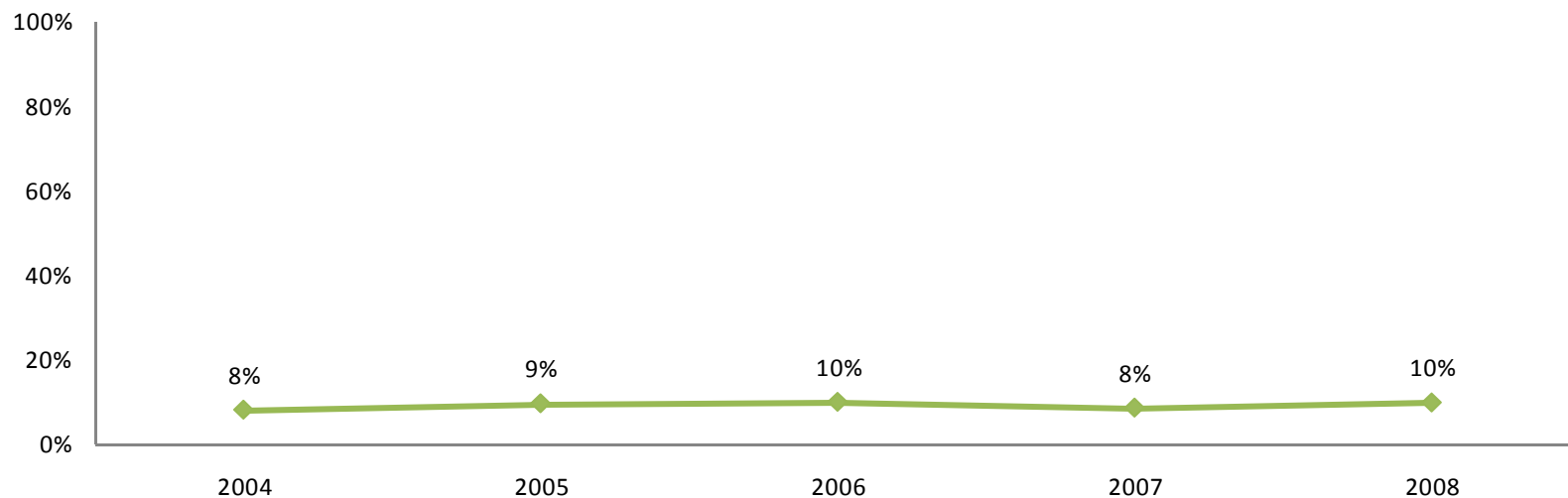

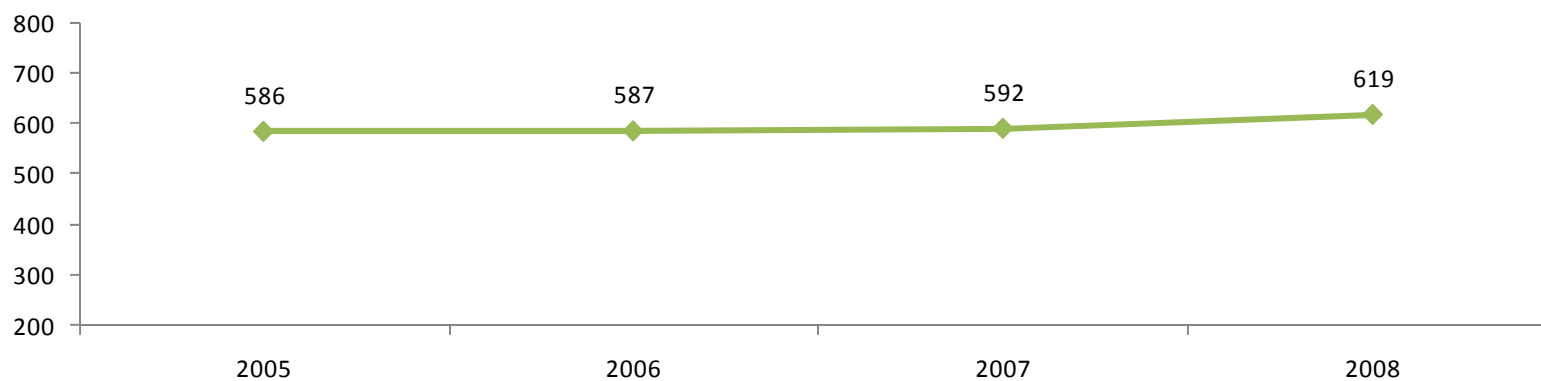

### Average GMAT Score (Business) of Entering Students

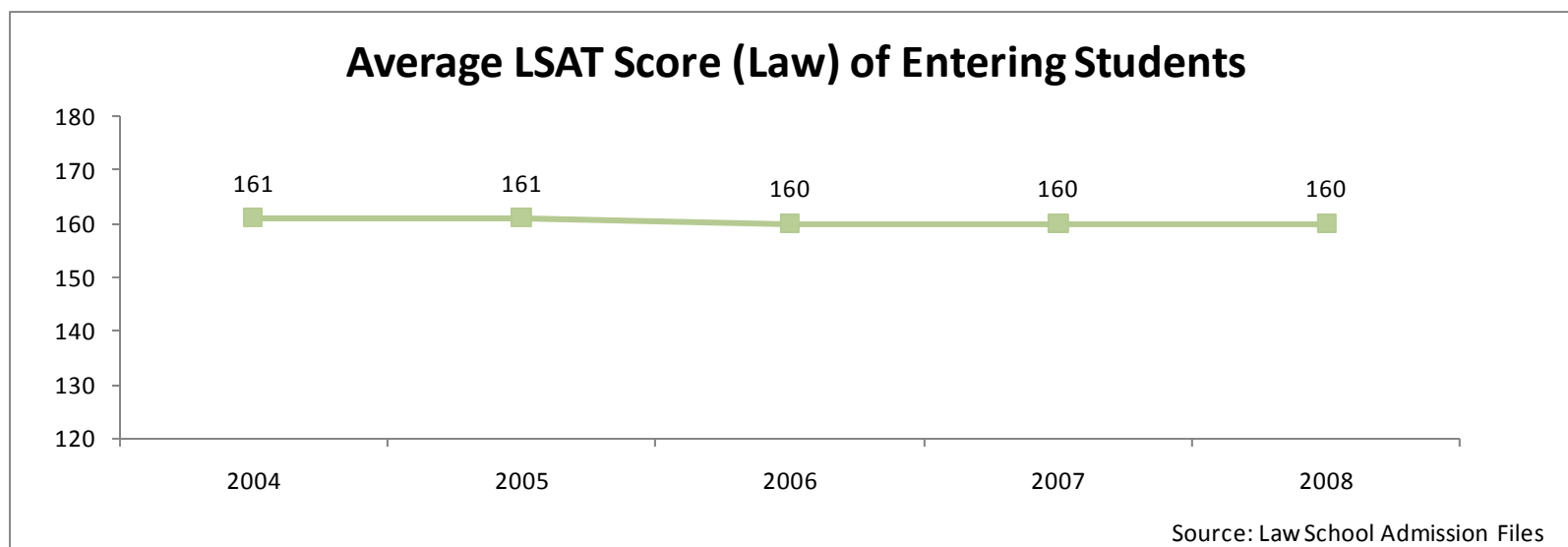

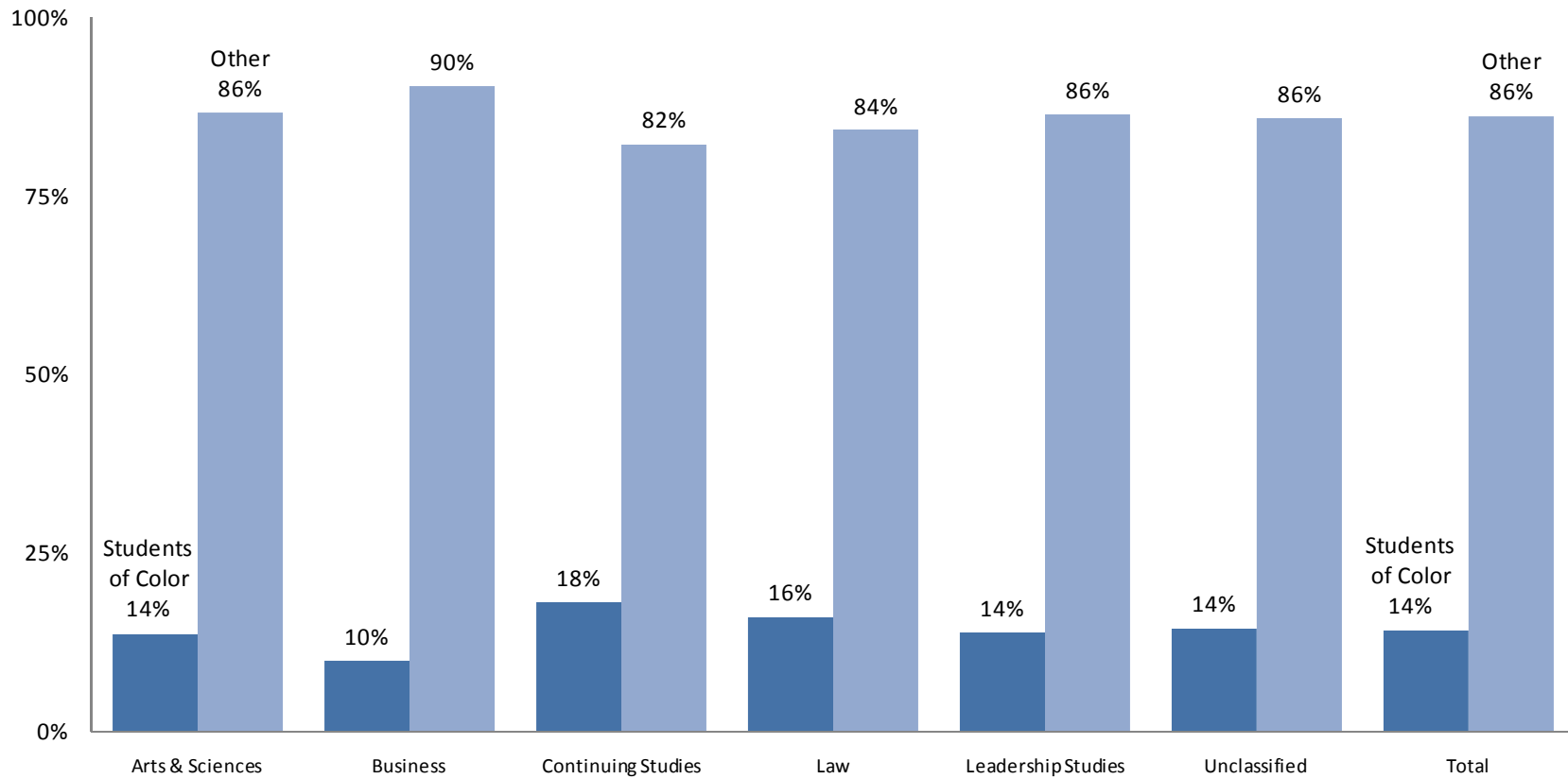

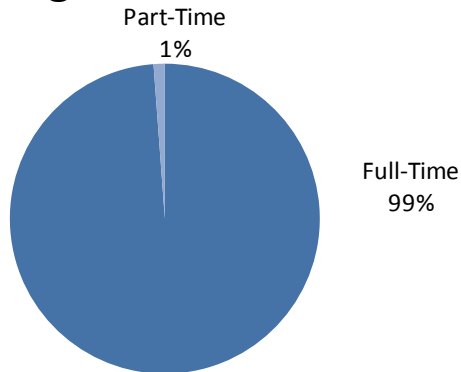

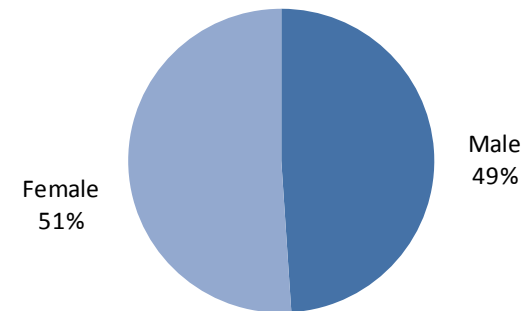

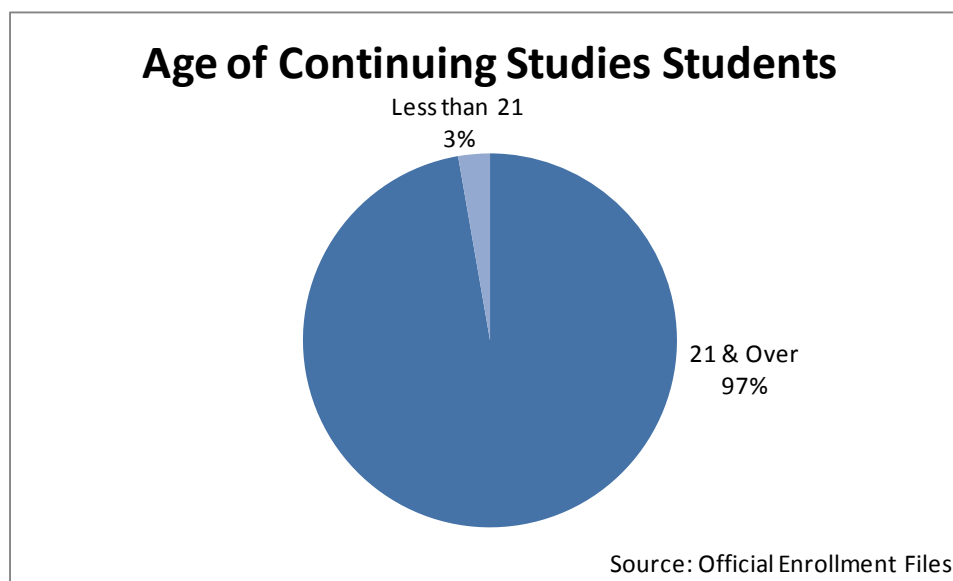

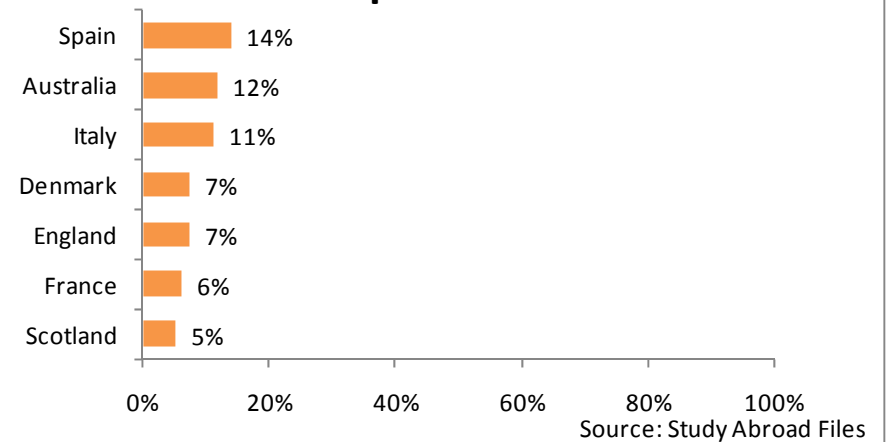

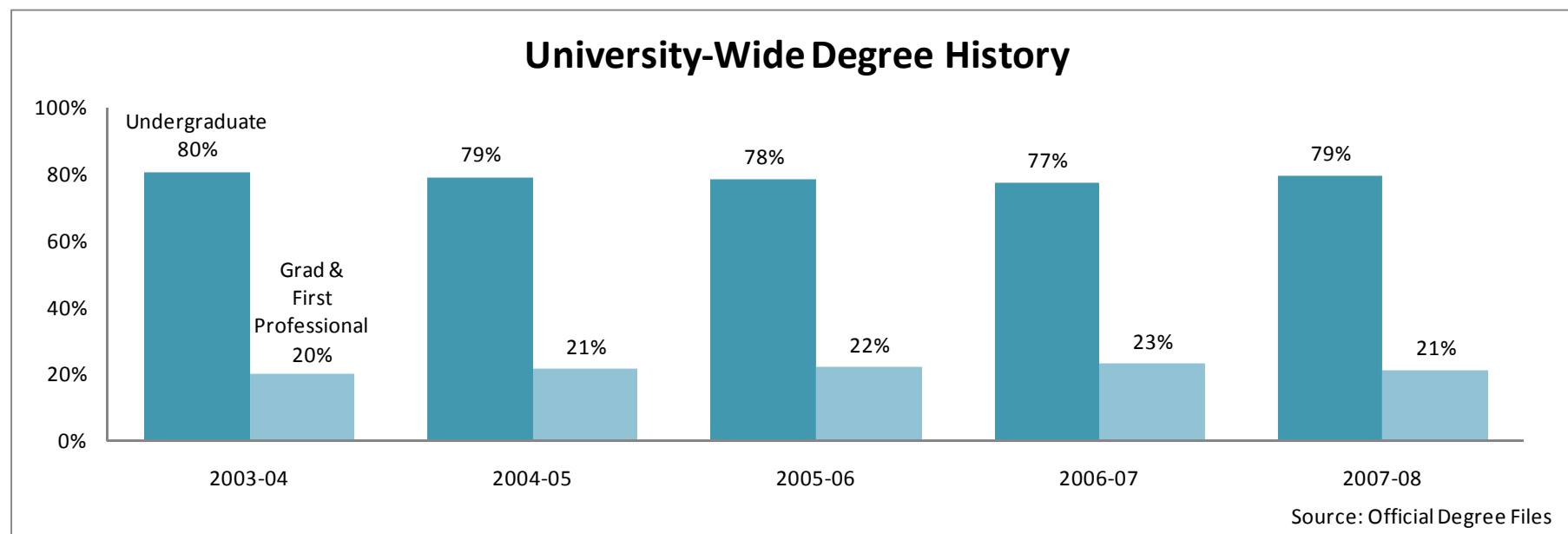

### Race/Ethnicity of Employees by EEO Classification

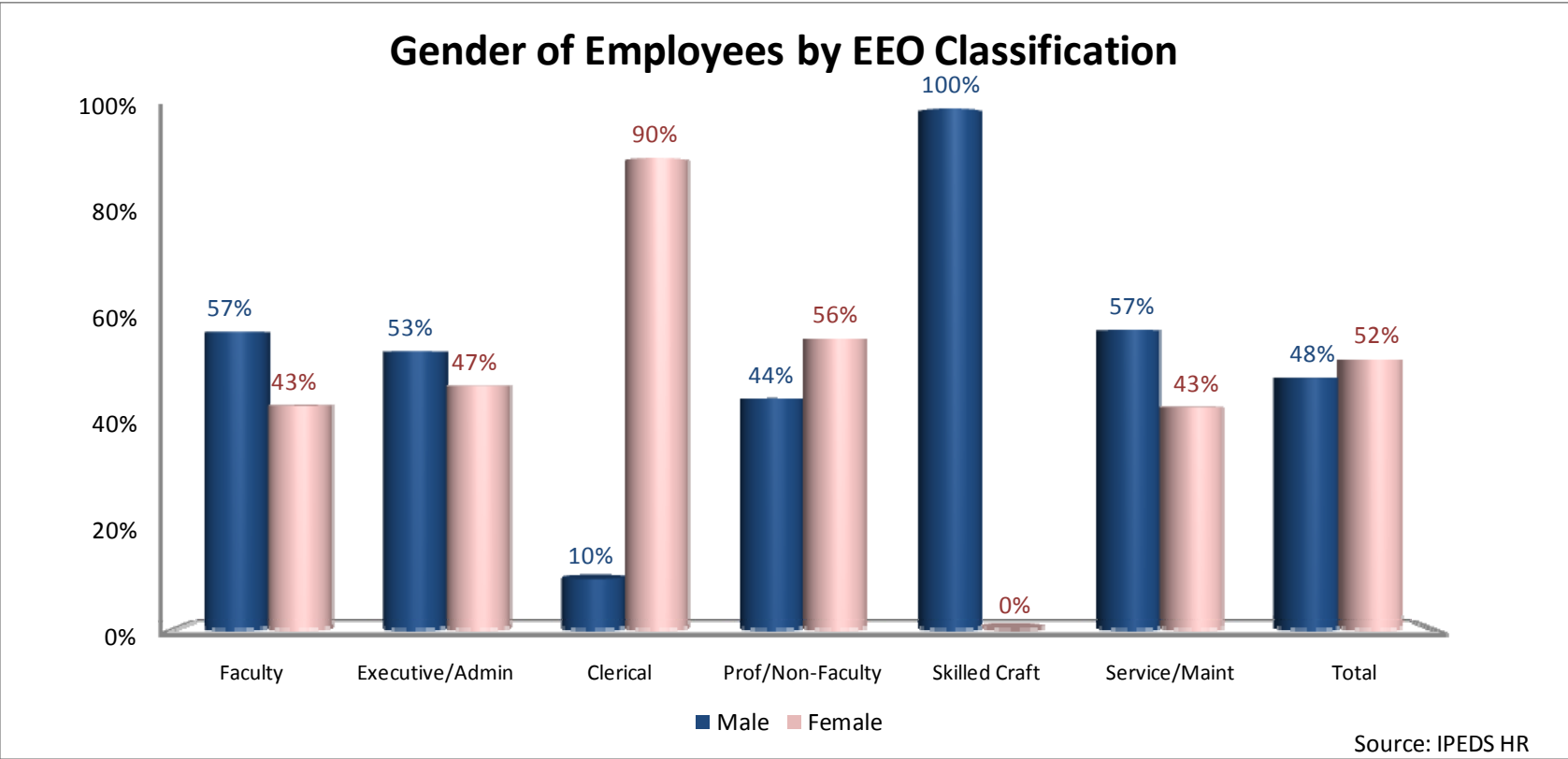

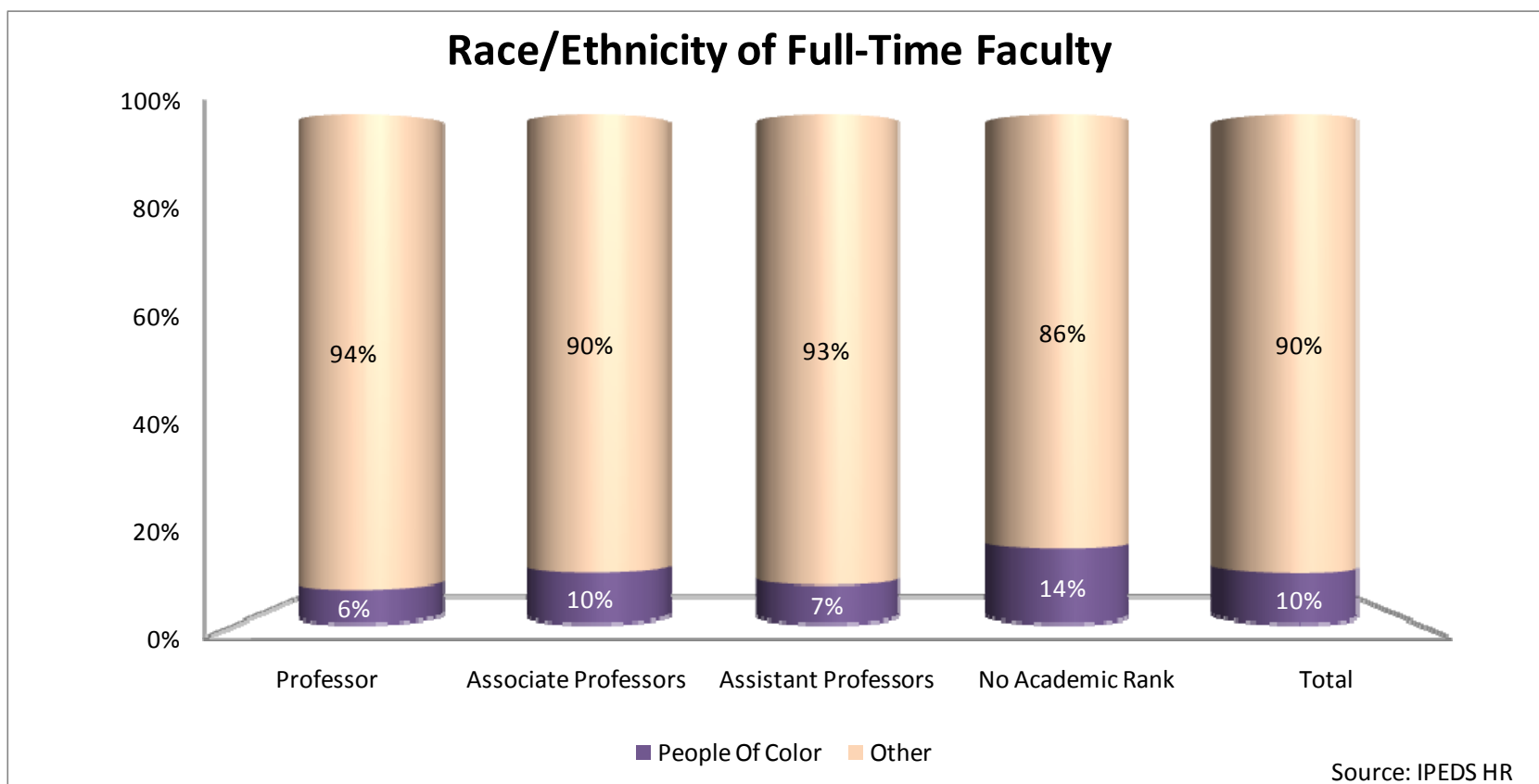

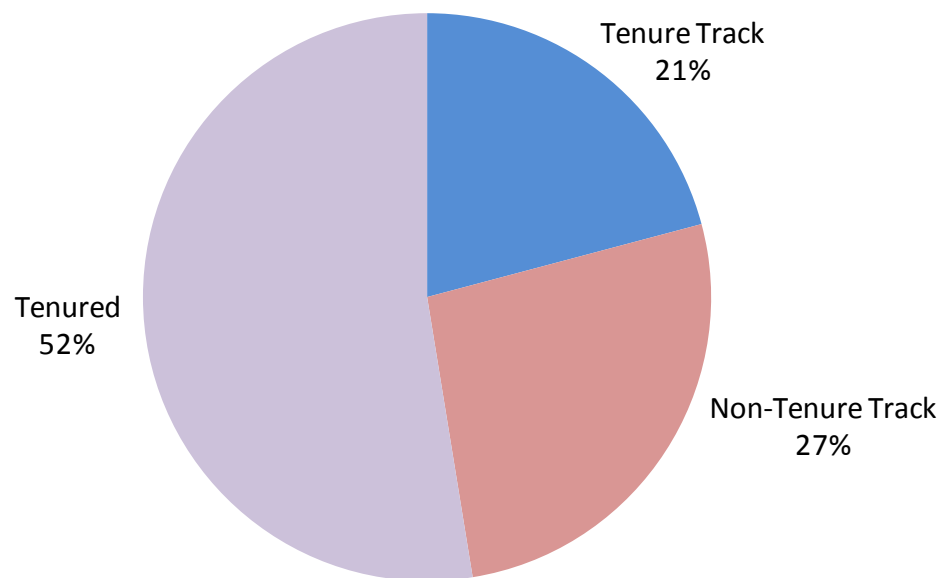

## Tenure Status of Full-Time Faculty



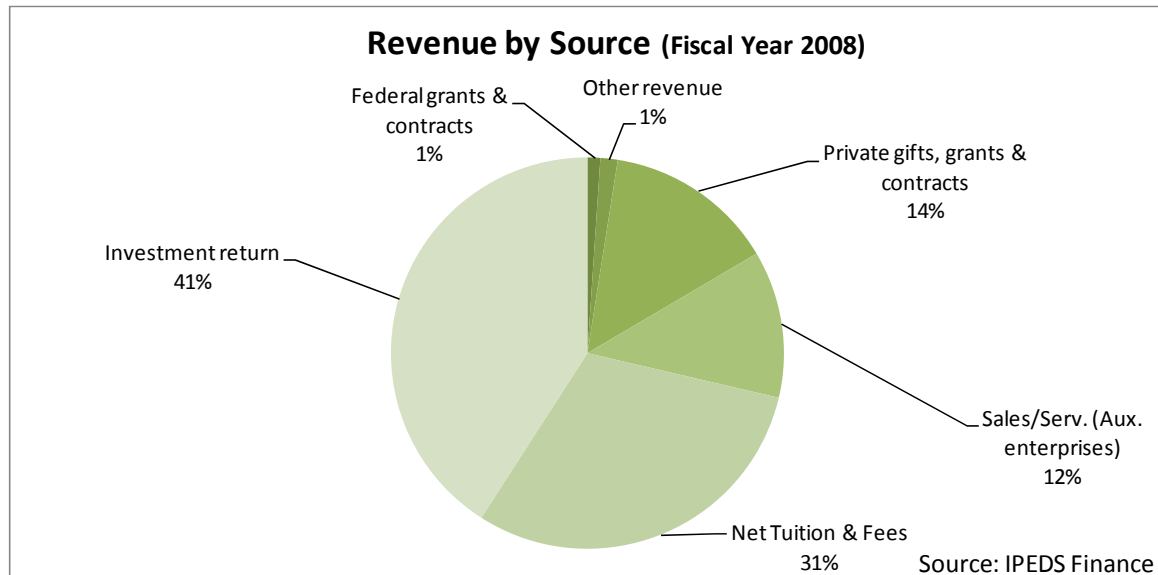
