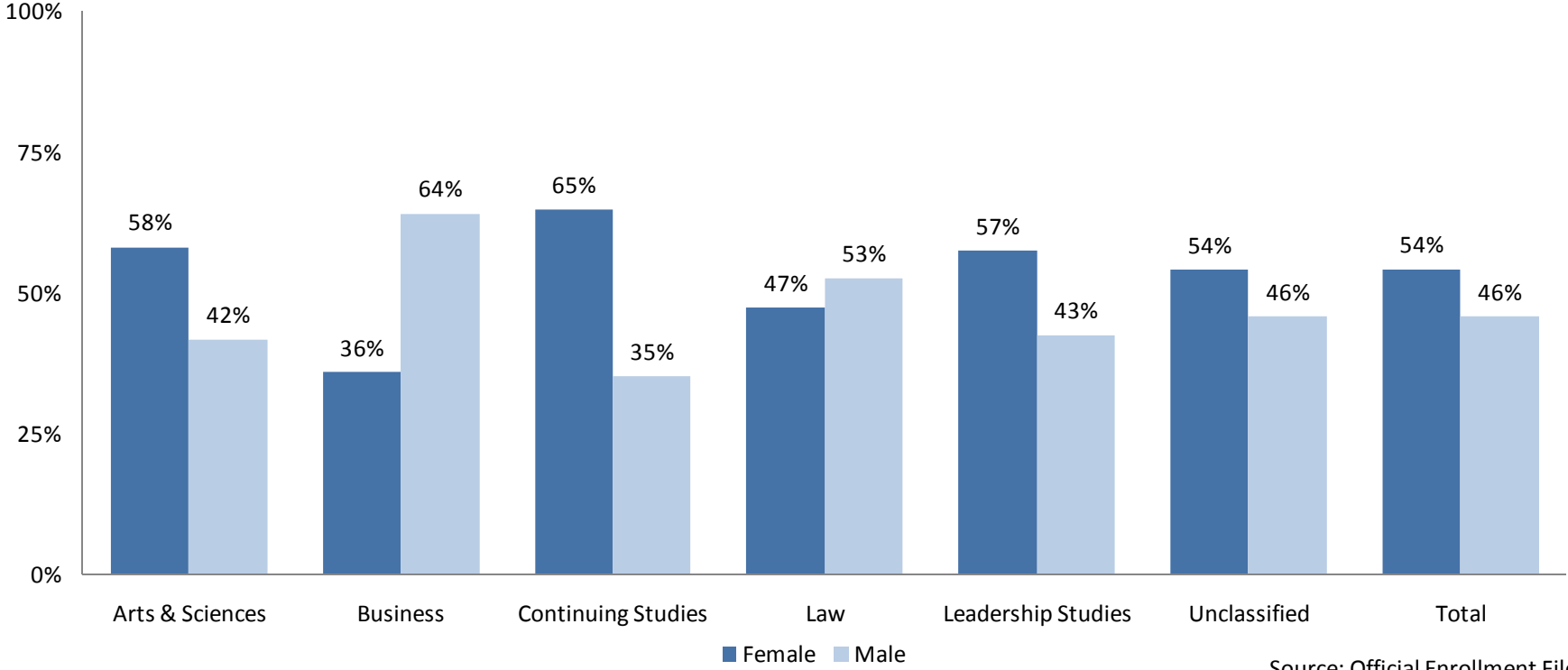

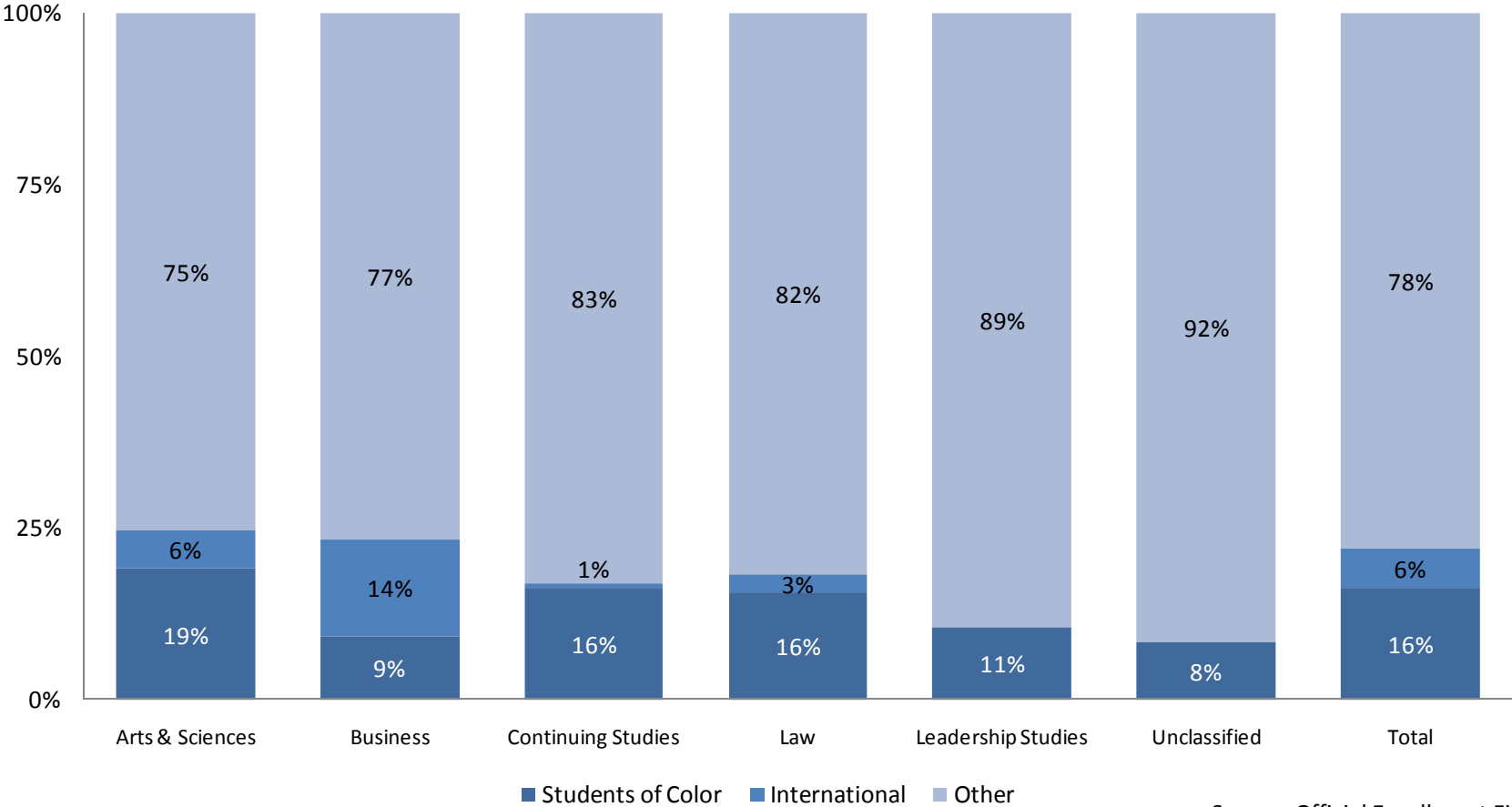

(Includes Dec '08, May & Aug '09 graduates)



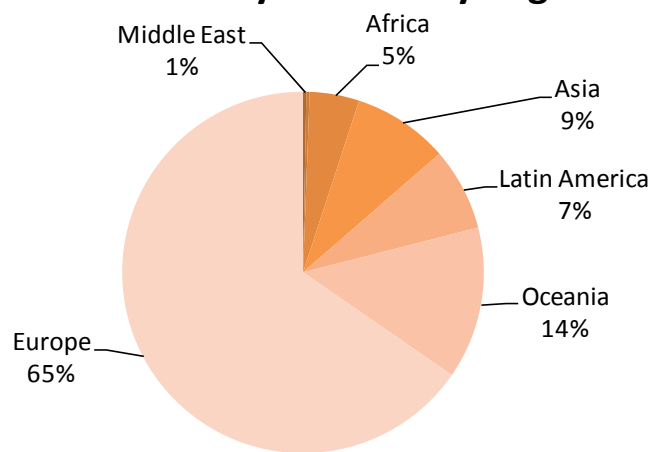

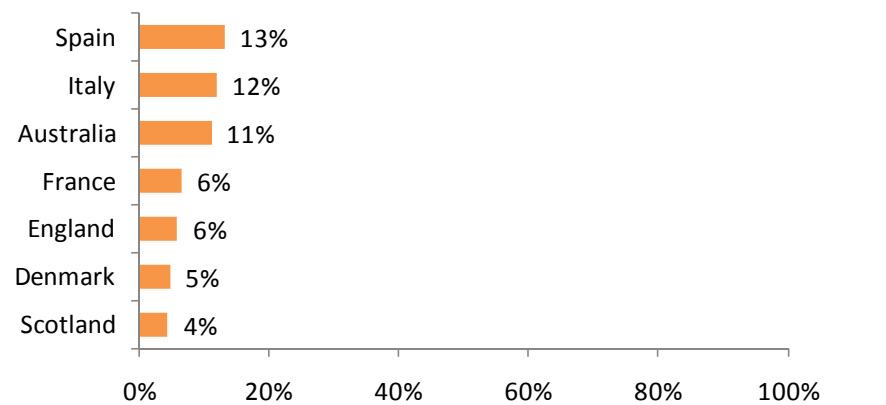

### Race/Ethnicity of Employees by EEO Classification

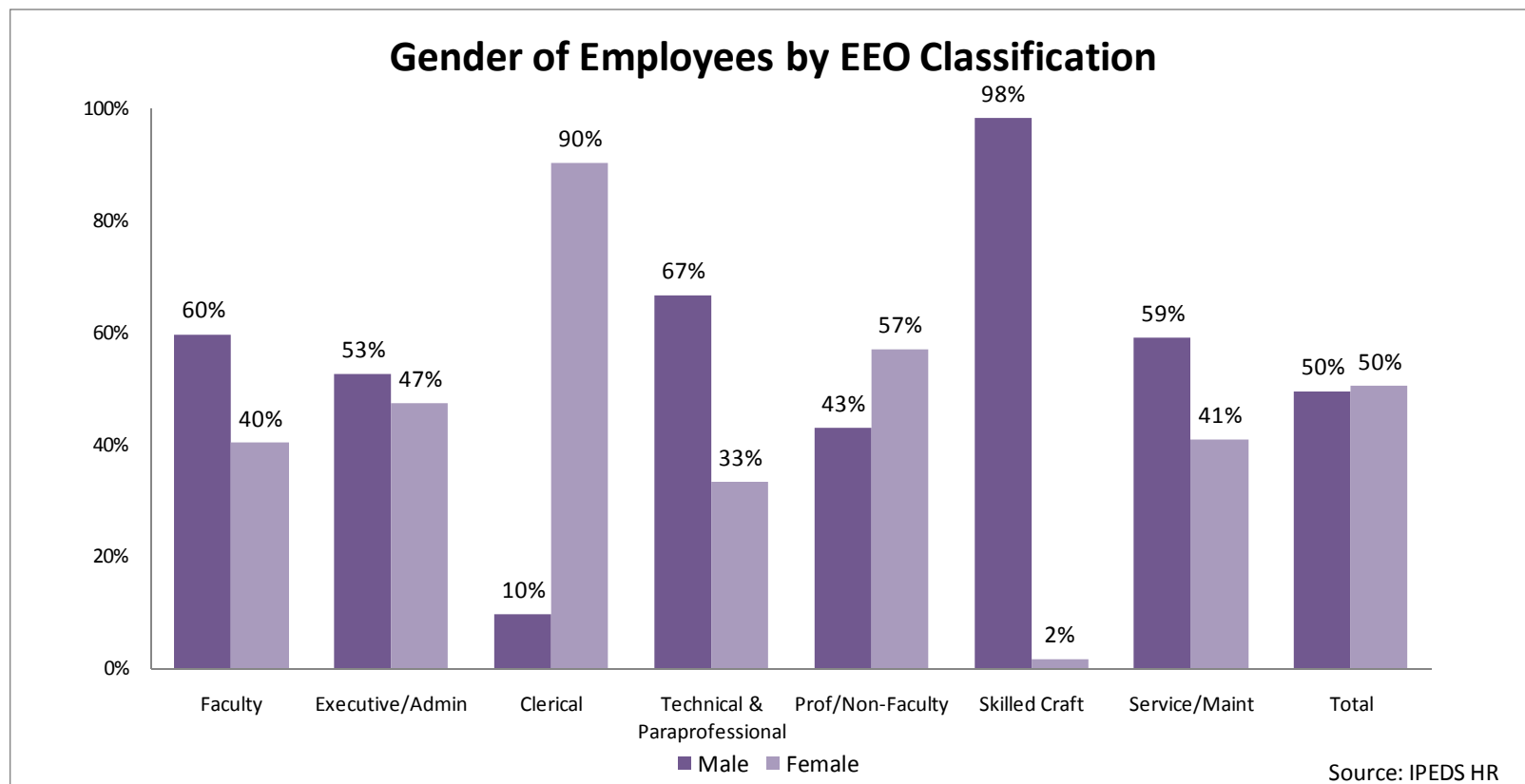

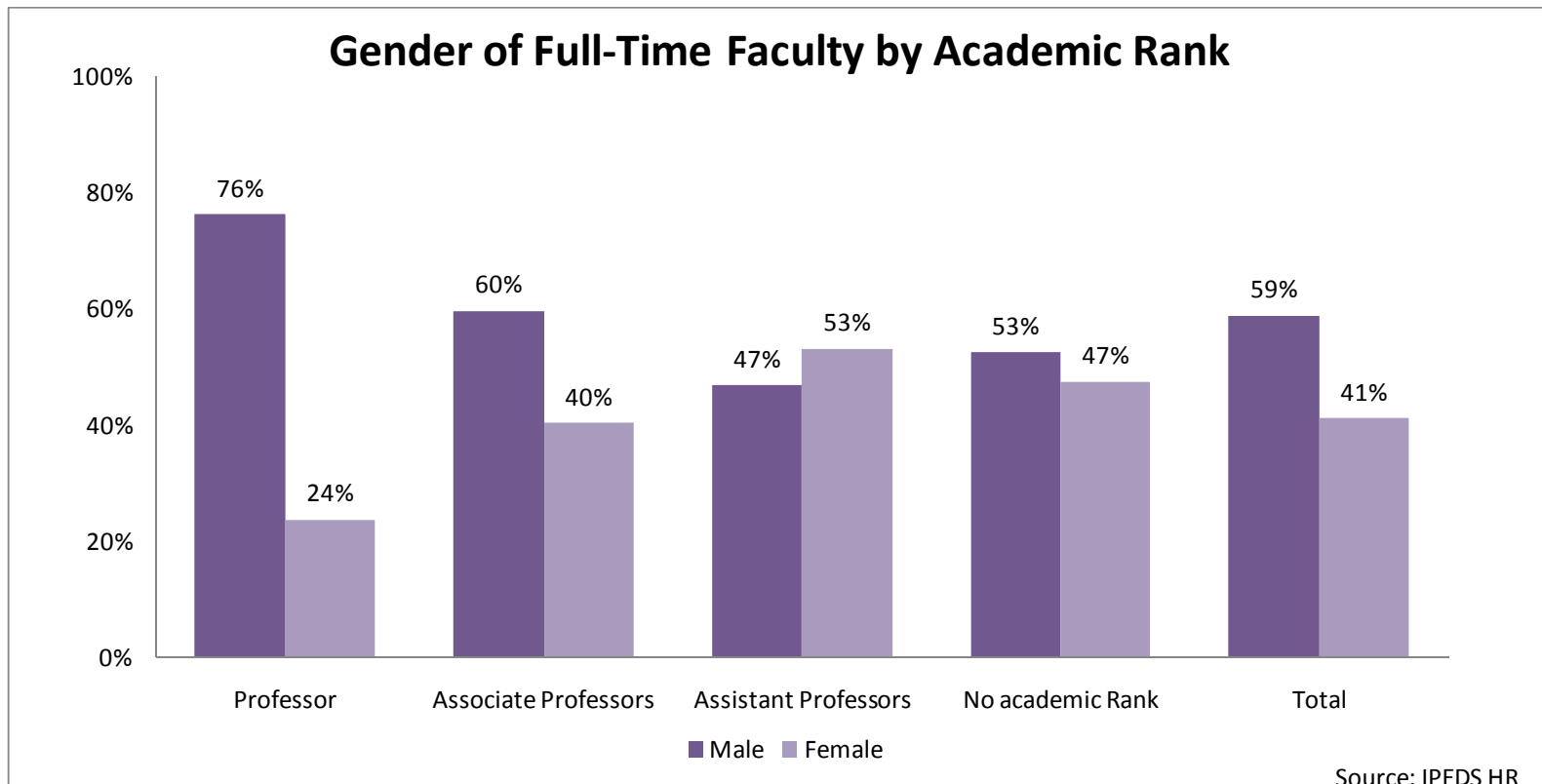

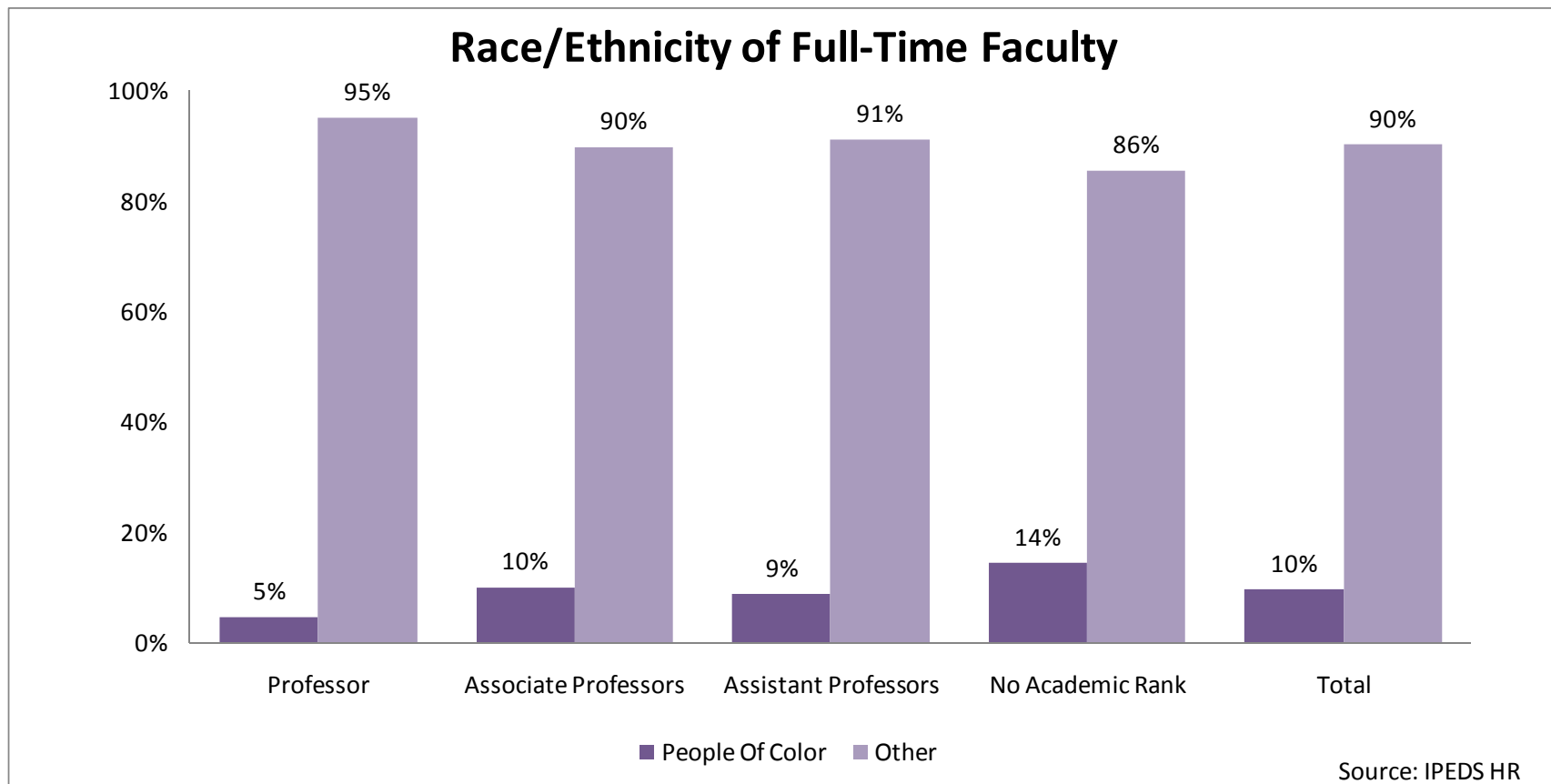

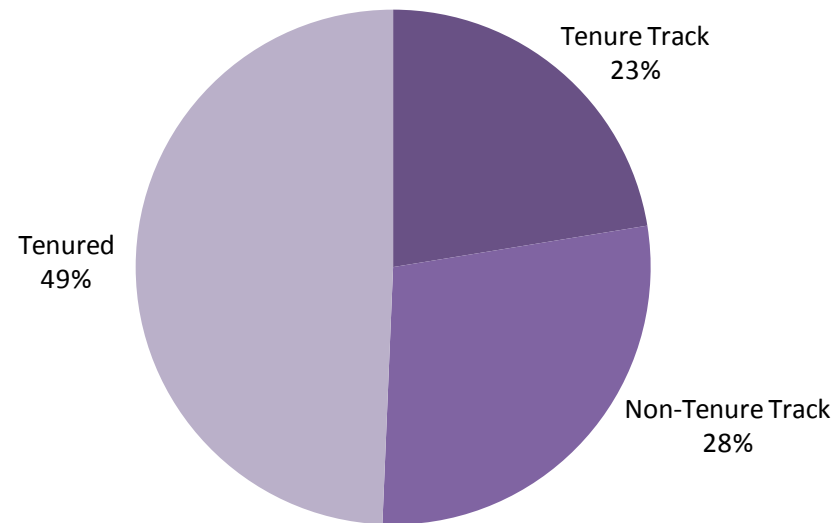
