University of Richmond Senior Exit Survey Class of 2022 | Overall Results

The University of Richmond Senior Exit Survey was administered online from March 14 through June 7, 2022 to seniors who graduated from the Schools of Arts & Sciences, Business, and Jepson (December 2021, May 2022, and August 2022). The purpose of the survey is to gain insight into students' satisfaction with their college experience. Of the 760 students invited to participate in the online survey, 263 responded, resulting in a 35% response rate.
