

In addition to the GA – Teaching category, GAs are also reported separately by the following categories: Research; Management; Business and Financial Operations; Computer, Engineering, and Science; Community Service, Legal, Arts, and Media; Library and Instructional Support; and Healthcare Practitioners and Technical.

³ For degree-granting institutions that have 15 or more full-time staff members, library-related occupations are reported separately as: Archivists, Curators, and Museum Technicians; Librarians; and Library Technicians. For all other institutions, library-related occupations are reported in the single category called "Librarians, Curators, and Archivists."
