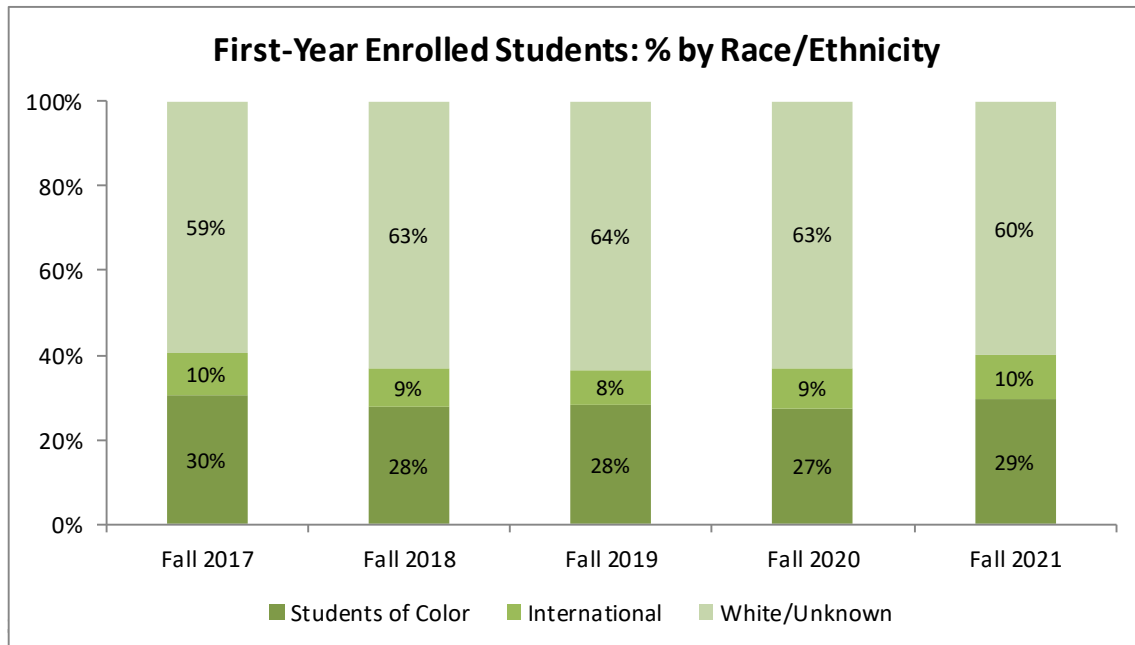

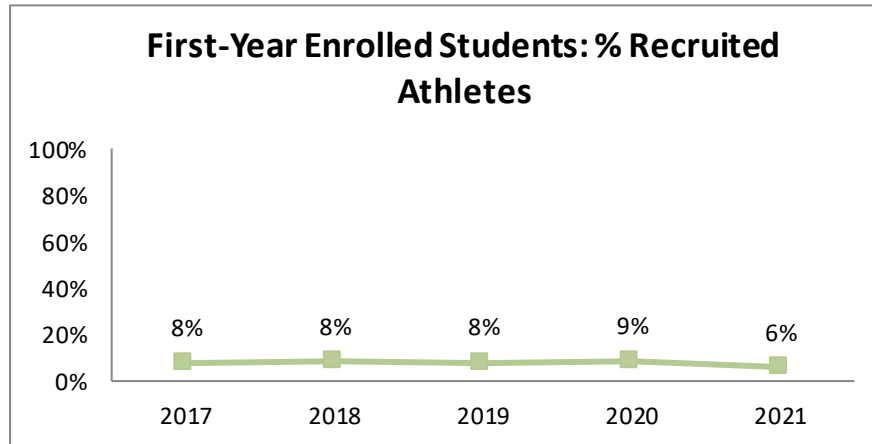

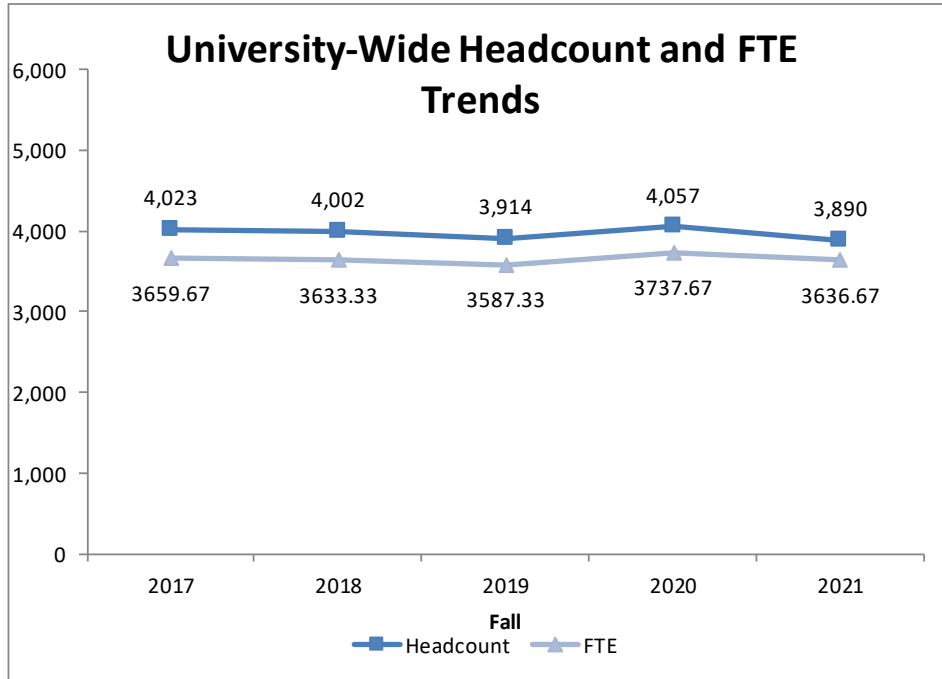

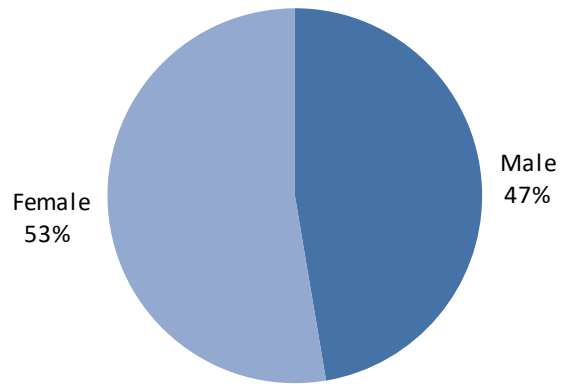

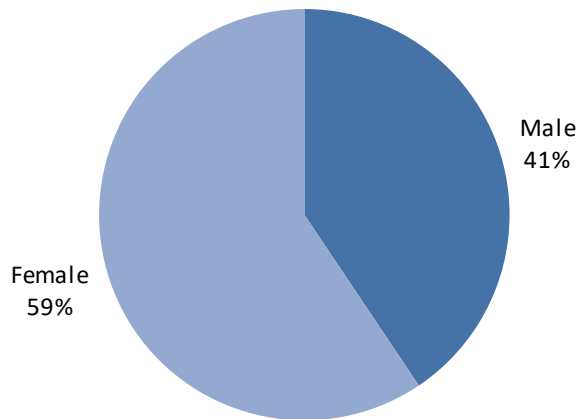

### Gender of Traditional Graduate Students

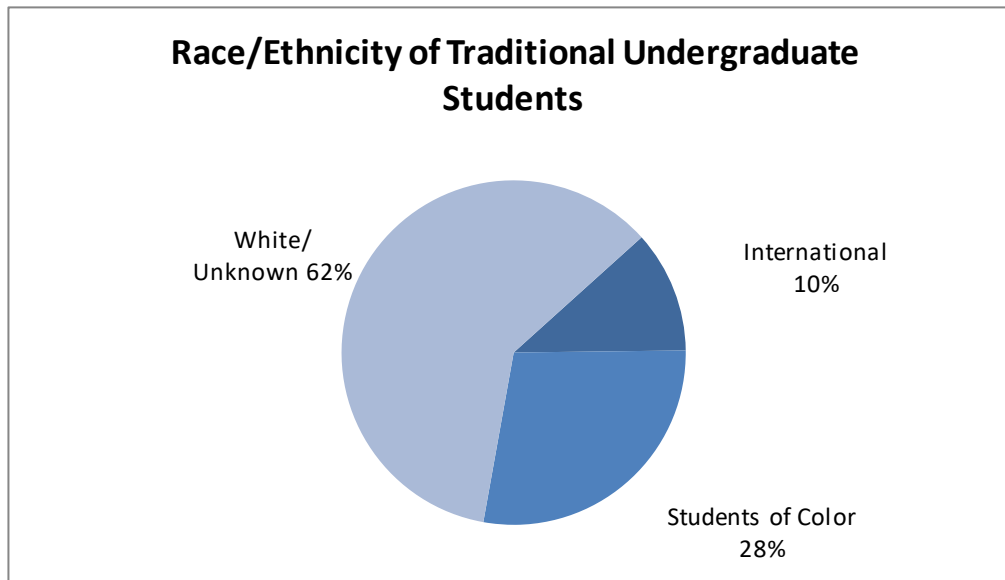

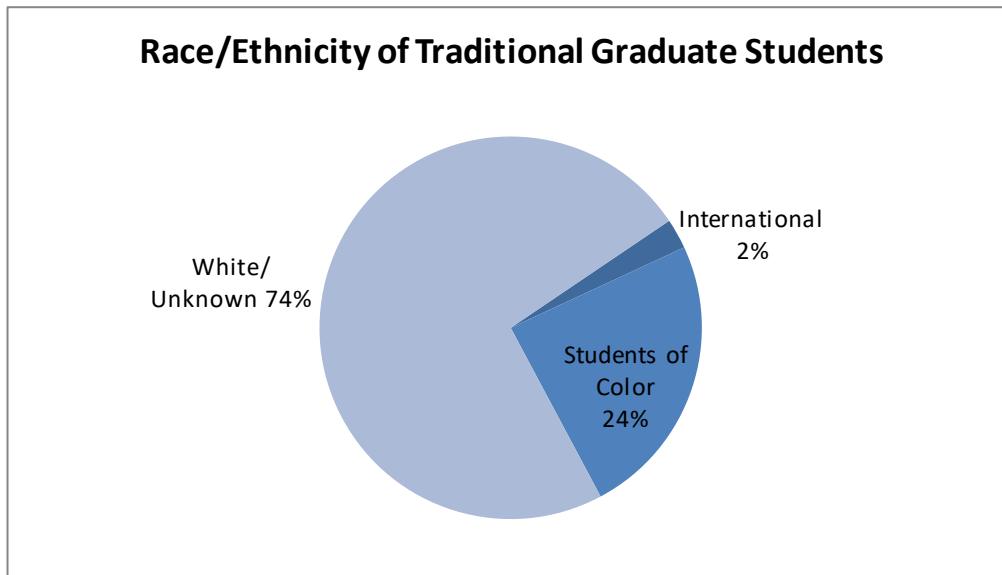

### Full-time Faculty by Diversity



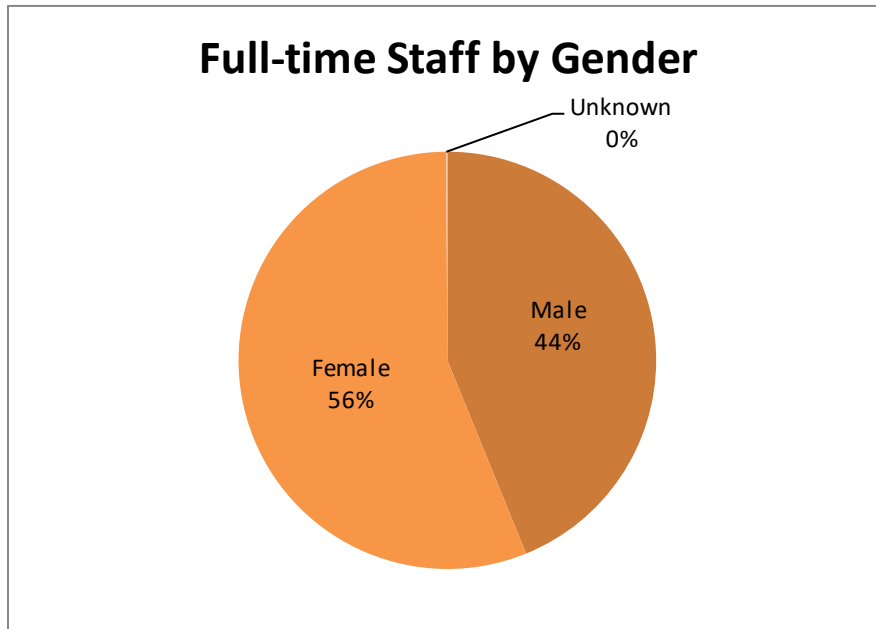

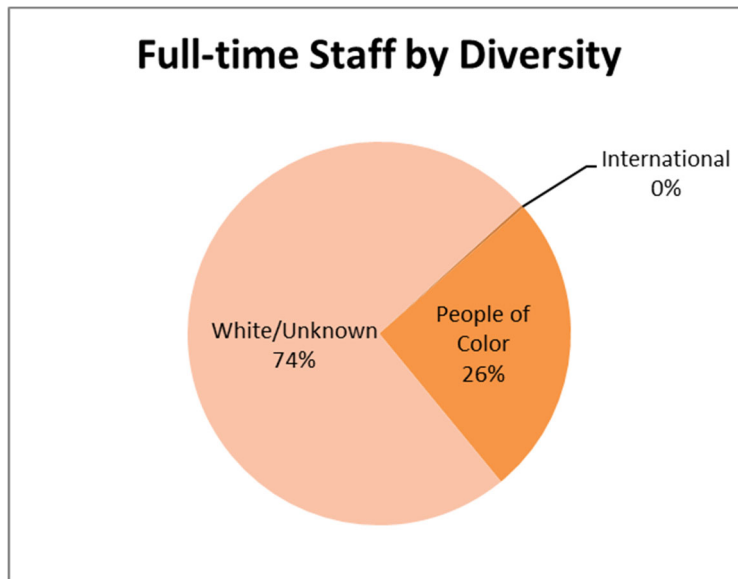
