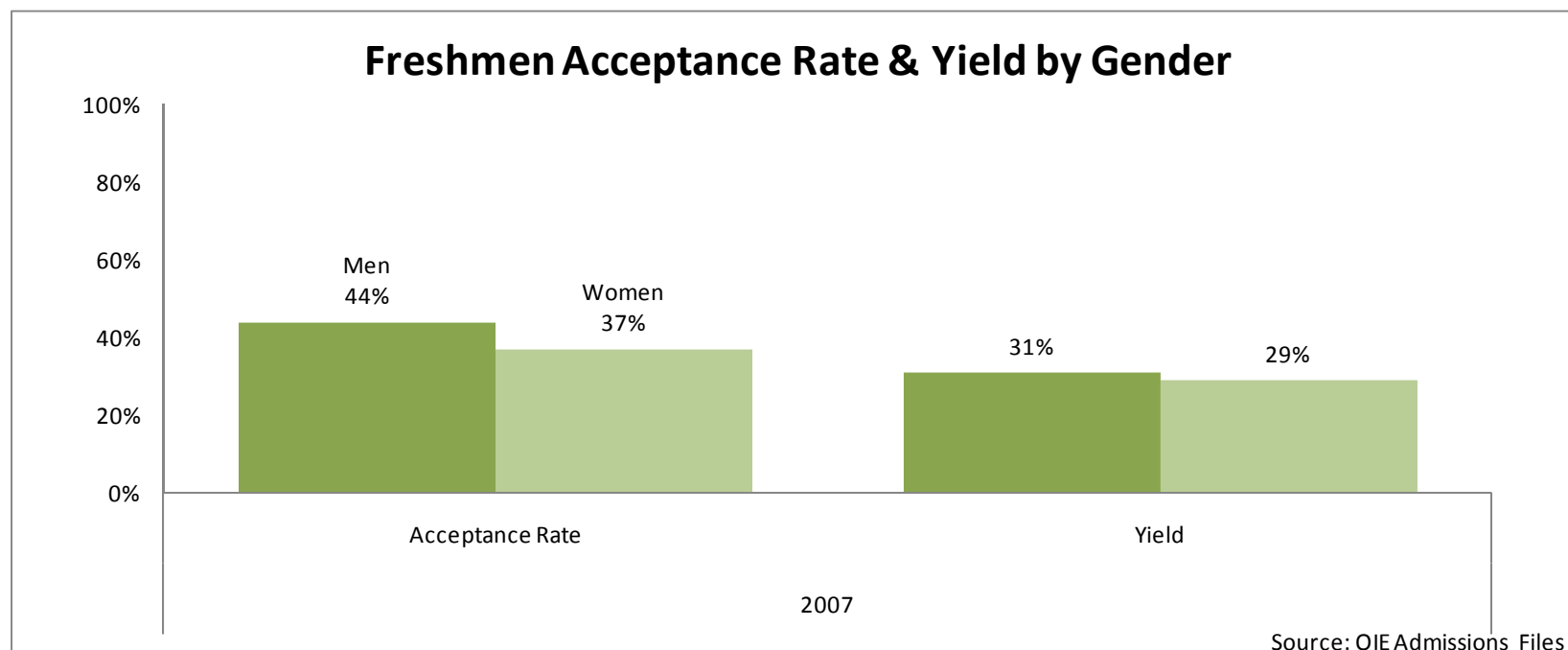

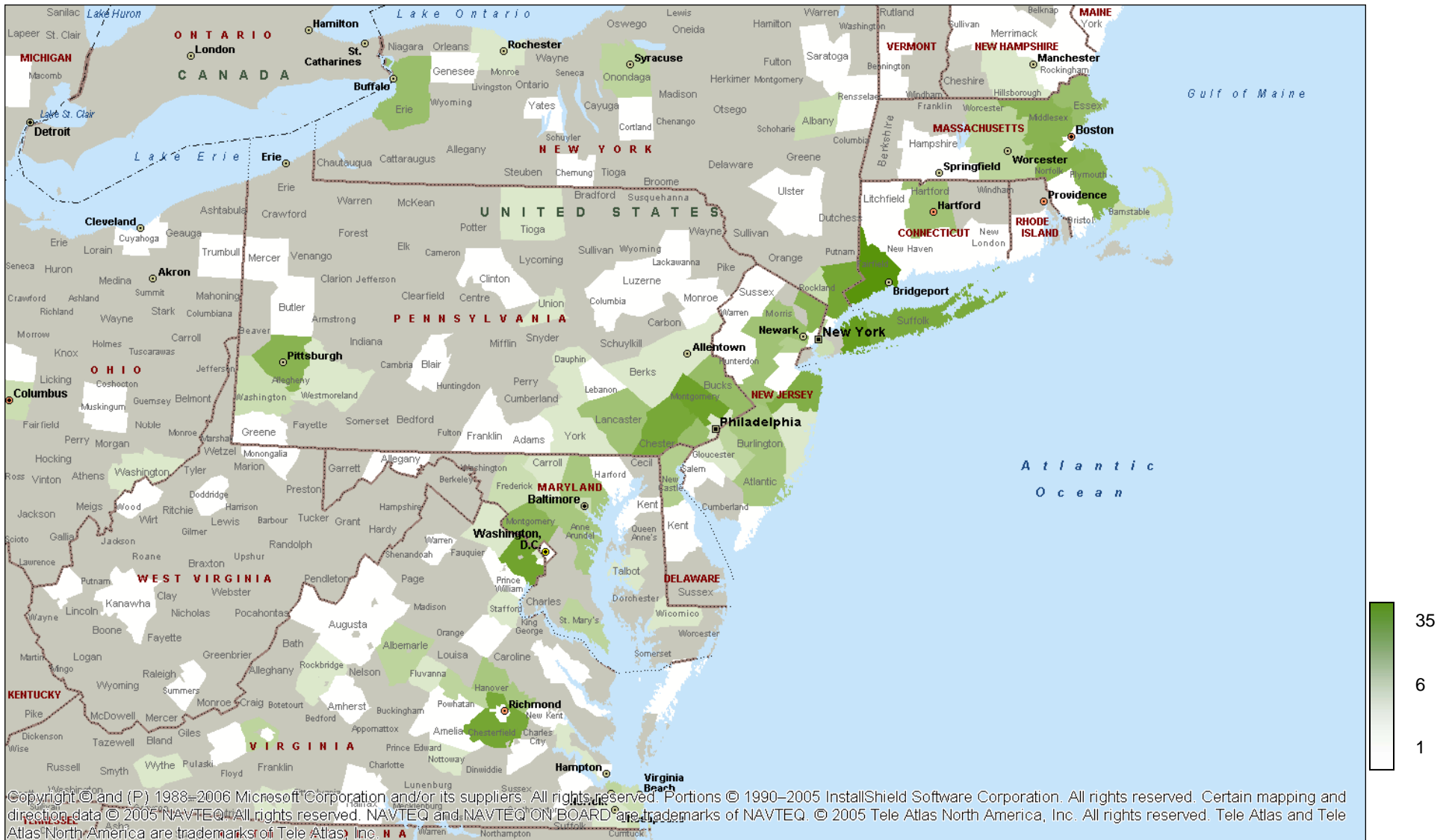
Freshmen by State

Freshmen in High Concentration Areas by County

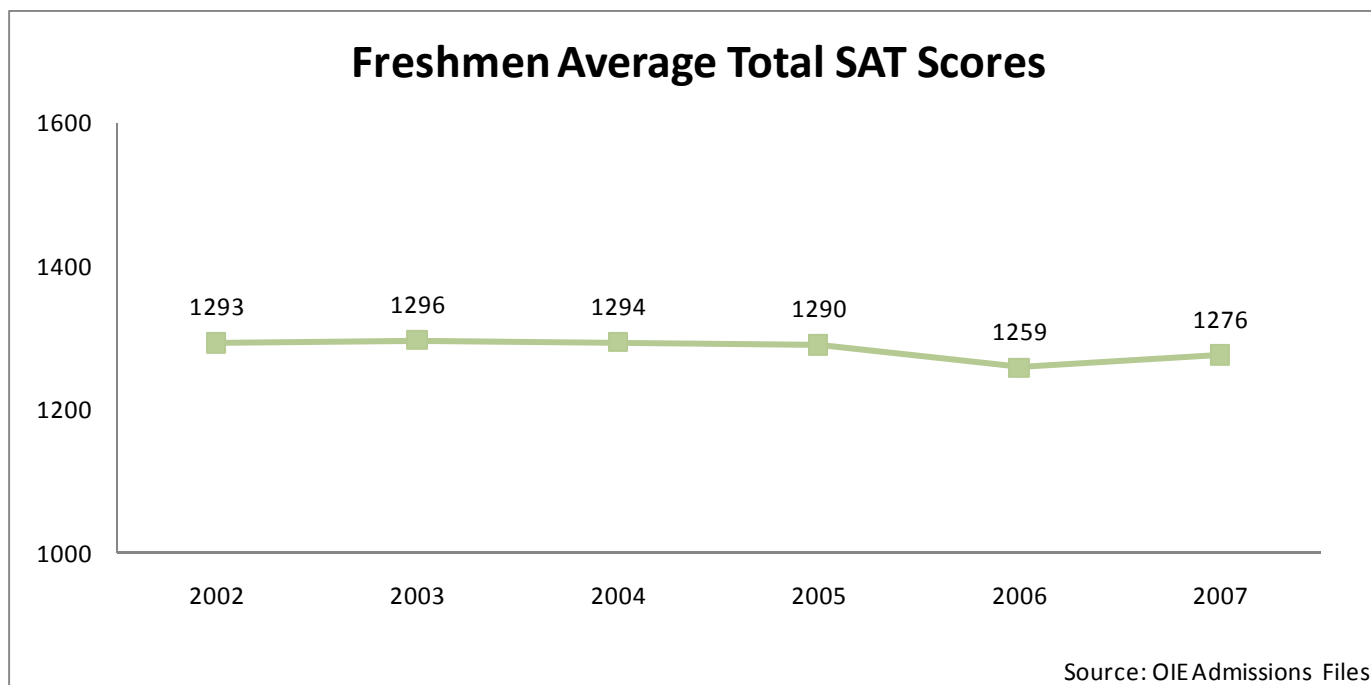

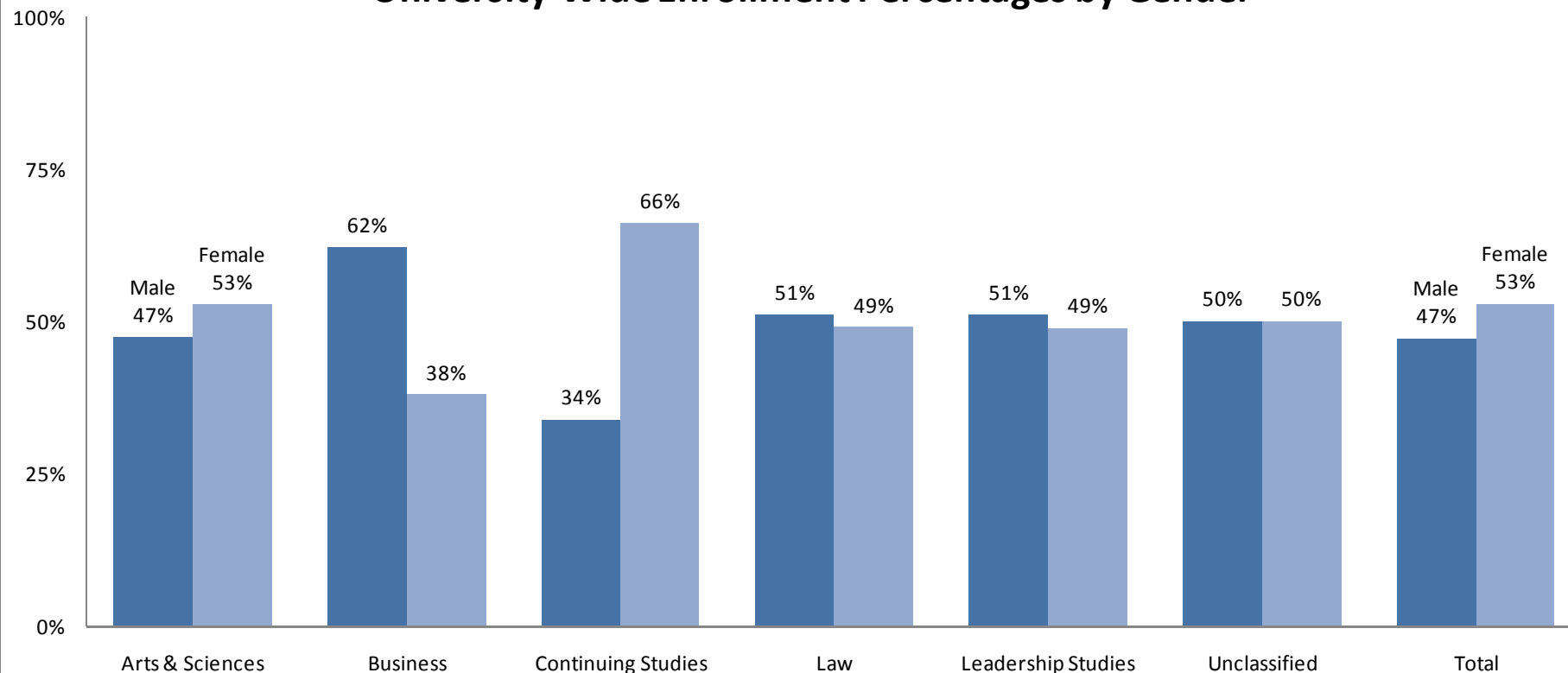

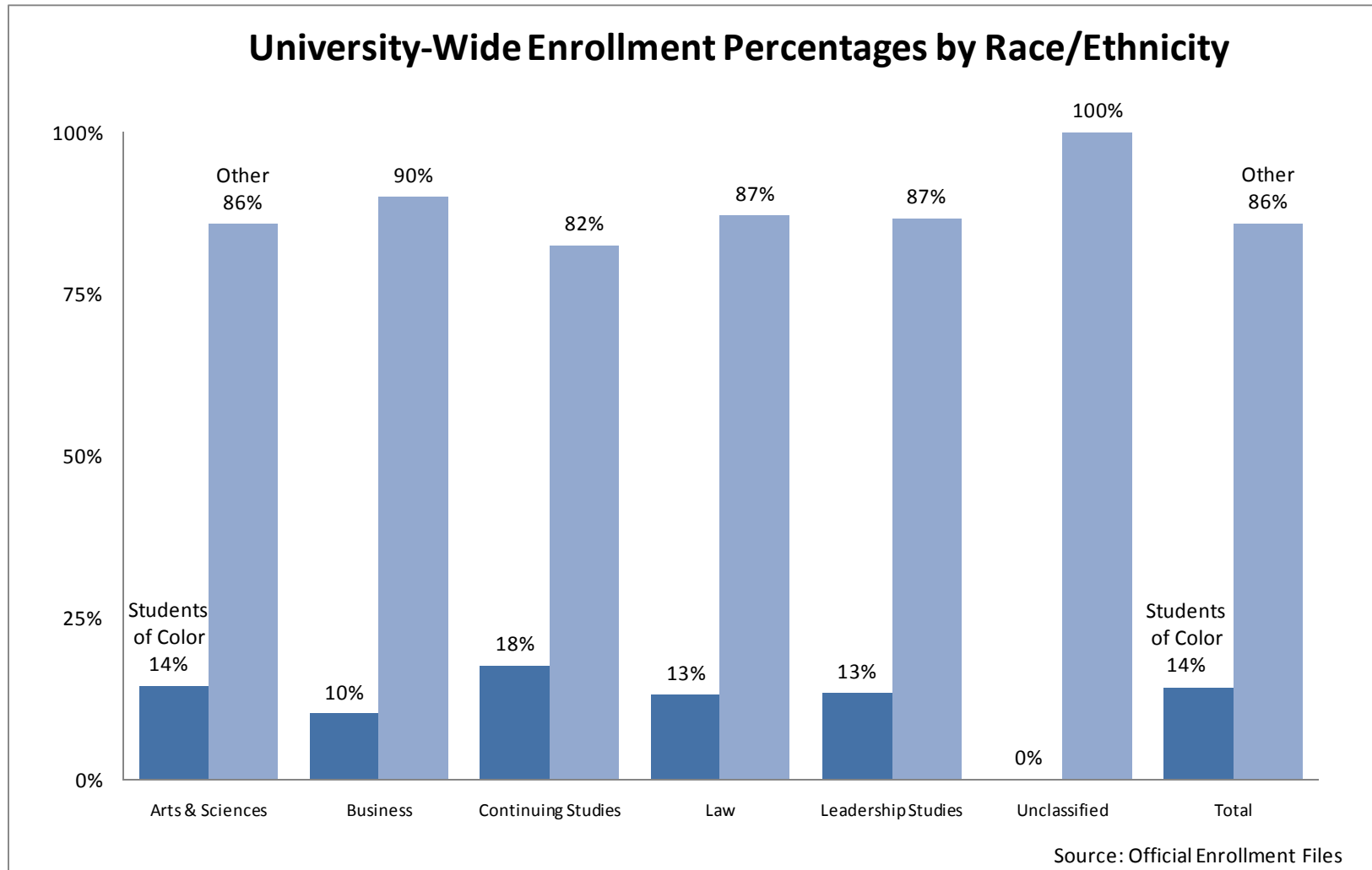

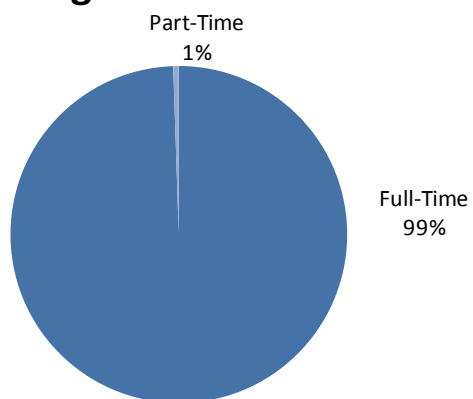

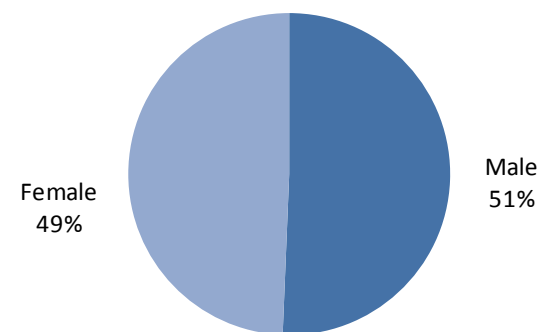

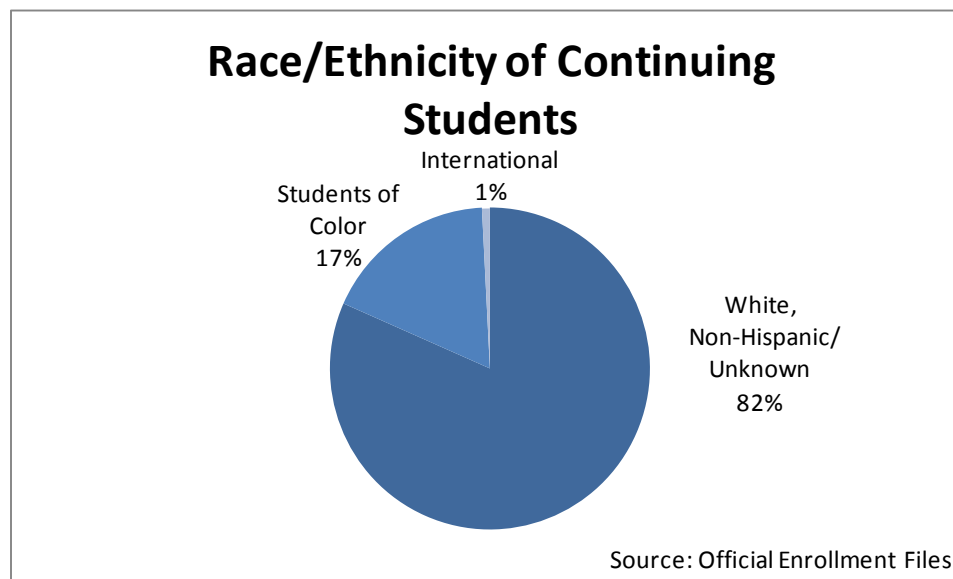

(Includes Dec 06, May & Aug 07 graduates)



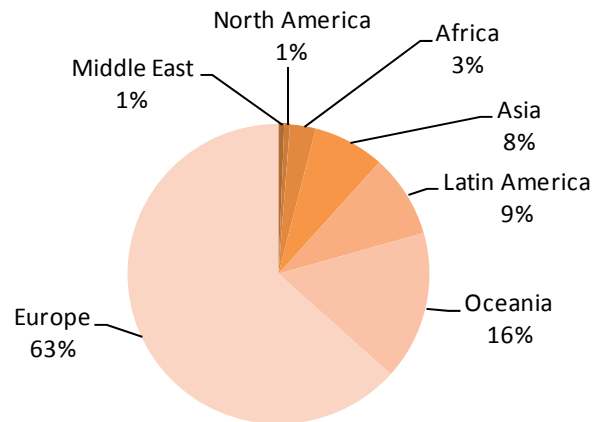

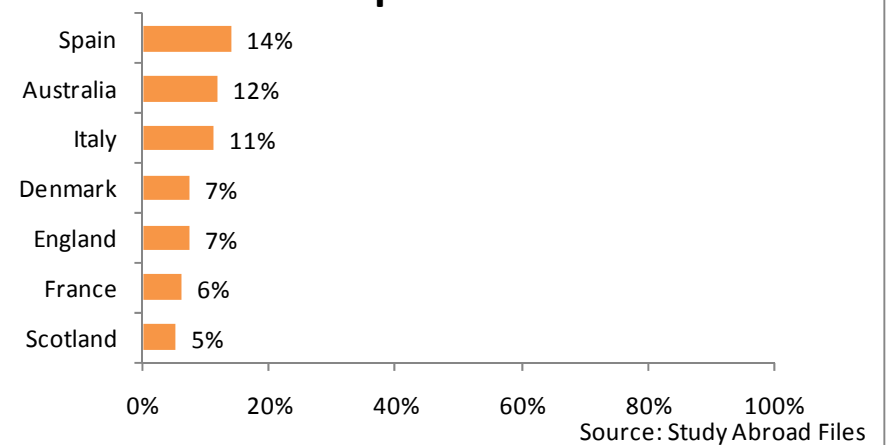

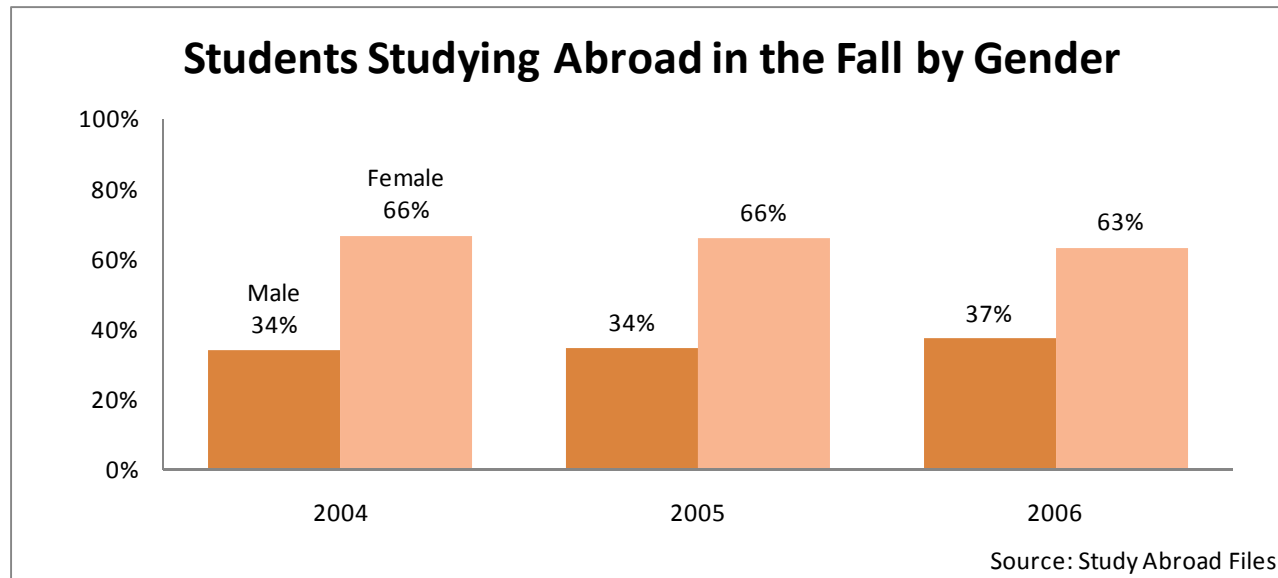

Degrees Conferred (2006-07)

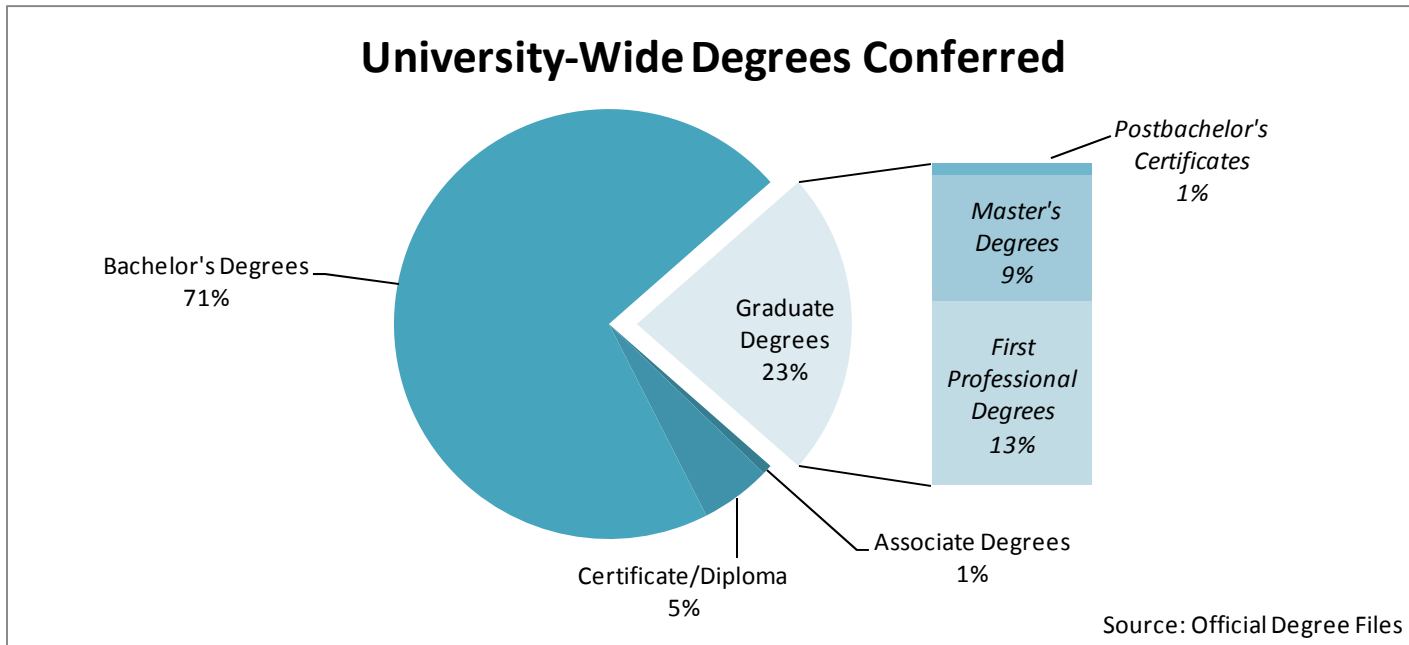

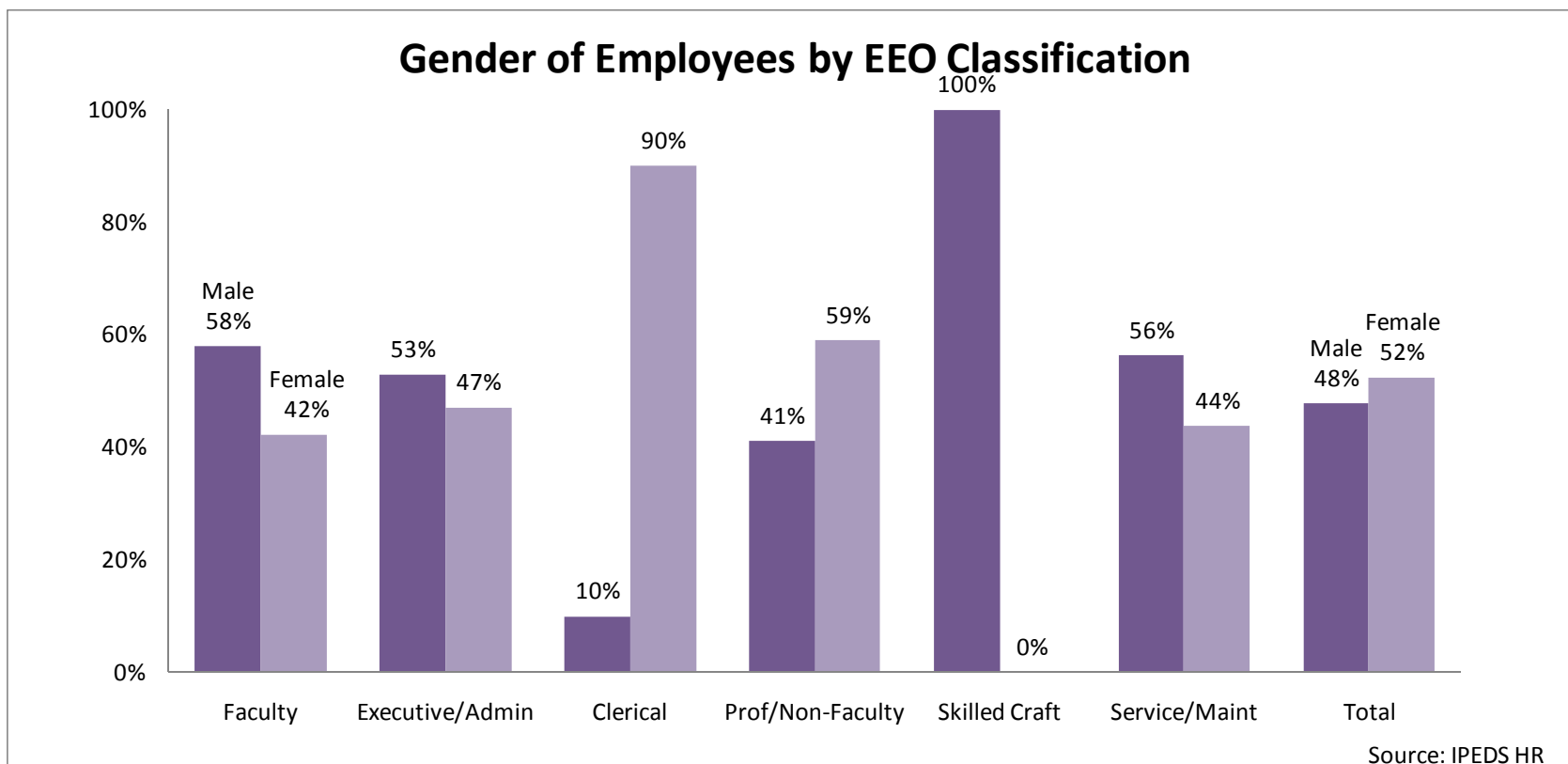
